Inter-Testament Period: 400 years of Silence. **No Prophetical Revelation Recorded**

- Silence until the Angel Gabriel speaks to Zacharias about John the Baptist
- Yet...During this time of silence major Political/Religious changes were taking place

400 years of **Political** Change between Old/New Testaments

Israel's History at a glance

- Israel engulfed in idolatry since leaving Egypt in 1500BC through...
- Time Kings of Israel [1000 BC 700BC] / 990 BC Kingdom is divided/Idolatry rampant/**God has enough**
- 720 BC Israel taken captive to Babylon under Nebuchadnezzar: Daniel and others in Babylon
- Daniel prophesies rise/fall of current world powers 500 years earlier: Babylon/Medo-Persia/Greece/Rome

400 BC Begin as Israel is back in the land

- 430-333 BC Judea still under rule of current world power Persia
- 333 BC Alexander the Great conquers Persia [Modern Iran] and dies there in 323 BC despairing more land to conquer

- 323 BC Alexander's territory divided between his 4 Generals
- **312 BC** Syria/Egypt fight for control of Judea. Egypt wins
- 285-247 BC OT translated from Hebrew-Greek in Alexandria Egypt
 - a) Translated by 72 men/6 from each of 12 tribes. Called the **Septuagin**t; i.e.70
 - b) Each scribe independently translating produce **identical translations**
 - c) Catholic Apocrypha written. Not considered inspired but historic
- **198 BC** Greek **Antiochus the Great** [III] takes Jerusalem from Egypt for Syria [ok]
- 168 BC [Son] Antiochus Epiphanes [IV] defiles temple with sacrificing pig
 - a) Hated the Jews. Pre-curser to Anti-Christ as was Nero as was Hitler.

When these happenings were reported to the king, he thought that Judea was in revolt. Raging like a wild animal, he set out from Egypt and took Jerusalem by storm. He ordered his soldiers to cut down without mercy those whom they met and to slay those who took refuge in their houses. There was a massacre of young and old, a killing of women and children, a slaughter of virgins and infants. In the space of three days, eighty thousand were lost, forty thousand meeting a violent death, and the same number being sold into slavery. 2 Maccabees 5:11–14



b) Known as the Madman: Abomination of Desolation

In an act of brazen disrespect, Antiochus raided the temple in Jerusalem, stealing its treasures, setting up an altar to Zeus, and sacrificing swine on the altar. When the Jews

expressed their outrage over the profaning of the temple, Antiochus responded by slaughtering a great number of the Jews and selling others into slavery. He issued even more draconian decrees: performing the rite of circumcision was punishable by death, and Jews everywhere were ordered to sacrifice to pagan gods and eat pig flesh.

Syria now ruling Israel under the Madman Antiochus Epiphany; God Manifest

- 166 BC- 63 BC Maccabean period
 - c) Priest in Judea named Mattathias revolts against Syrian rule
 - d) Incredible Jewish suffering/heroism during this time
 - e) Judas Maccabaeus AKA "The Hammer" rises among Jews
 - f) Jews see miraculous victory over Syrian control and over Antiochus...

But the all-seeing Lord, the God of Israel, struck him with an incurable and invisible blow. As soon as he stopped speaking he was seized with a pain in his bowels, for which there was no relief, and with sharp internal tortures— 6 and that very justly, for he had tortured the bowels of others with many and strange inflictions. 7 Yet he did not in any way stop his insolence, but was even more filled with arrogance, breathing fire in his rage against the Jews, and giving orders to drive even faster. And so it came about that he fell out of his chariot as it was rushing along, and the fall was so hard as to torture every limb of his body. 8 Thus he who only a little while before had thought in his superhuman arrogance that he could command the waves of the sea, and had imagined that he could weigh the high mountains in a balance, was brought down to earth and carried in a litter, making the power of God manifest to all. 2 Maccabees 9:5-9 [Pride before the fall e.g. Pharaoh, Hamon, Judas, Nero, Hitler etc.]

400 years of Political Change along with... 400 years of <u>Religious</u> Change between Old/New Testaments

- No more wood/stone idol worship after the Israel's 70 years of captivity in Babylon
- Jewish Law keeping becomes the "new" idol of Jews

Their Idol became their *own perceived ability to keep the law* **From a Relationship with God to a Religion without God Result:** Self-Righteousness / Pride on Steroids



At the time of Jesus birth...

 Everyday language changed from Hebrew to Aramaic [Hebrew still spoken in Synagogues]

NOTE: Synagogues came into existence only after the Babylonian captivity

Four Groups <u>never mentioned</u> in the OT emerge from these Synagogues, now the center of Jewish religious life: Pharisees, Sadducees, Scribes and the Herodians

- 1. **Pharisees:** The dominant party. Purpose was to defend the Jewish ways of life against foreign influences. Strict legalists with strong belief in the OT. Nationalists wanting to restore the kingdom back to the line of David, thus they were **both a religious and political power**. Today they would be known as **far right politically**/fundamental religiously.
- 2. Sadducees: Wealthy socially-minded and wanting to get rid of "tradition". As today most of the rich are liberal. They were...Liberal in theology to the point of rejecting the supernatural. Because of this they opposed the Pharisees. As with Greek Epicureans, Sadducees would agree "eat, drink and be merry, for tomorrow we die" and "we will overcome our bodily appetites by feeding them" Did not believe in angels or the afterlife. This is why they were Sad-you-see.
- 3. **Scribes:** The only group that seems to have roots in the OT from the days of Ezra. These "hair-splitters" [sin-sniffers] were concerned with the letter, not the spirit of the law. NOTE: These guys knew where the Messiah was to be born when asked by Herod and were **satisfied with just that knowledge alone** ...but not interested in going Bethlehem to find Him! **Of them Jesus would say...**

John 5:39 You search the Scriptures, for in them you think you have eternal life; and these are they which testify of Me. ⁴⁰ But you are not willing to come to Me that you may have life. Pharisees, Sadducees, Scribes and lastly...

4. **Herodians:** This party of Jesus day were **strictly political** and seeking to keep King Herod on the throne as **they stayed in control**

Pharisees, Sadducees, Scribes and the Herodians: Four Groups never mentioned in the OT emerge from these relatively new man ordained Synagogues, now the center of Jewish religious life

Life/Death/Resurrection/Ascension of Jesus is recorded in the Gospels; Good News

1 Corinthians 15:45 And so it is written, "The first man Adam became a living being." The last Adam became a life-giving spirit.

Romans 5:12 ... just as through one man [Adam] sin entered the world, and death through sin, and thus death spread to all men, because all sinned...14 Nevertheless death reigned from Adam to Moses, even over those who had not sinned according to the likeness of the transgression of Adam, who is a type of **Him who was to come**. 15 But the free gift is not like the offense. ¹⁸ Now the **birth of Jesus Christ** was as follows: After His mother Mary was betrothed to Joseph, before they came together, she was found with **child** of the Holy Spirit.

Bob Ross: Here comes your bravery test...

How big is your God? Mary was found with child *of the Holy Spirit*

Joseph can only believe what seems obvious...

¹⁹ Then Joseph her husband, being a just man, and not wanting to make her a public example, was minded to put her away secretly.

- Betrothed: Married but without sealing the deal
- Adultery: Stoned to death in public square
- **Joseph:** Just man chooses to secretly divorce Mary

Love of Joseph for Mary: Protecting even in his pain

Sometimes God calls us to some really hard stuff. Period. Result: His Glory and our Growth

²⁰ But while [Joseph] thought about these things, behold, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream, saying, "Joseph, son of David, do not be afraid to take to you Mary your wife, for **that which is conceived in her is** of the Holy Spirit. ²¹ And she will bring forth a Son, and you shall call His name JESUS, for He will save His people from their sins."

Don't be afraid Joseph. God is His Father. You name Him...Name Him Jesus [Salvation]

• Child conceived by the God the Holy Spirit through Mary...

²² So all this was done that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the Lord through the prophet, saying: 23 "Behold, the virgin shall be with child, and bear a Son, and they shall call His name **Immanuel**," which is translated, "God with us." [Isaiah 7:14]

- Virgin birth will bring forth Immanuel: God with us
 - 1. 100% Man through Mary

Q. Who could Bridge the Gap between sinful man and a Holy God

A. Holy God revealed as a perfect sinless man

Job 9:32 [There is no...] mediator between us, who may lay his hand on us both.

1 Timothy 2:5 For there is one God and one Mediator between God and men, the Man Christ Jesus...

He knows us intimately...

Psalm 103:14 For He knows our frame; He remembers that we are dust.

• God condescends to man in the person of Jesus Christ born of a virgin...

Hebrews 4:14 Seeing then that we have a great High Priest who has passed through the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast our confession. For we do not have a High Priest who cannot **sympathize with our weaknesses**, but was in all points tempted as we are, yet without sin. Let us therefore come boldly to the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy and find grace to help in time of need.

Hebrews 10:5 Therefore, when [Jesus] came into the world, He said [to the Father]: "Sacrifice and offering You did not desire, but a body You have prepared for Me.

[Cont.] **34** Then Mary said to the angel, "How can this be, since I do not know a man?" 35 And the angel answered and said to her, "The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and **the power of the Highest will overshadow you**; therefore, also, that Holy One who is to be born will be called the **Son of God**. 36 Now indeed, Elizabeth your relative has also conceived a son in her old age; and this is now the sixth month for her who was called barren. 37 For **with God nothing will be impossible."** 38 Then Mary said, "Behold the maidservant of the Lord! **Let it be to me according to your word**." - **Q.** What if I believe in God?
- A. Demons believe in God and shiver

...there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved

Q. What if I don't accept Jesus as my personal Savior but am sincere in what I do believe?A. Then you are sincerely wrong an don't have a Savior to save you from sin and hell

...there is **no other name** under heaven given among men by which we must be saved.

Q. Why is there no other Name by which to be saved? A. Because...

Jesus is the Eternal God come from heaven and manifested as a baby, He is God who became man and died on a cross for our sins.

How could there possibly be any other way?

John 14:6 "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.

 No one has ever been saved that has been saved in any other way than staking everything they have on the Sacrifice of Jesus.

Call His Name Jesus; i.e. Salvation. Call His name Immanuel; i.e. God with us

• Name above all Names. Call His Name Jesus

THE Name of Jesus, chosen by God for His Son, is also given to Him by all who truly know Him, and they give it to Him heartily, zealously, boldly. All of us call Him Jesus if we really know Him, and we are resolved to publish His Name abroad as long as we live. If He was Jesus in the cradle, what is He now that He is exalted in the highest heavens? As Emmanuel, God with us, His very Incarnation made Him Jesus, the Savior of men; but what shall we say of Him now that, in addition to His Incarnation, we have His Atonement; and beside His Atonement, His Resurrection; and beyond that, His Ascension; and, to crown all, His perpetual Intercession?

How grandly does the title of Savior befit Him now that He is able to save them to the uttermost that come unto God by Him, seeing He ever lives to make intercession for them! If in the arms of His mother He was the Savior, what is He now that He sits upon the throne of God? If wrapped in swaddling bands He was Jesus, the Savior, what is He now that the heavens have received Him? If in the workshop of Nazareth, and sitting in the temple among the doctors, He was Jesus, the Savior, what is He now that His infancy and childhood are over, and He is exalted far above all principalities and powers? If He was Jesus when on the cross, presenting Himself as an offering for His people, what is He now that He has by one sacrifice perfected forever them that are set apart? What is He now that He sits at the right hand of God till His enemies be made His footstool?

Let all who trust in Him unite in calling our Lord by this tender human Name of Jesus. Did He not call all believers by the endearing titles of mother, and sister, and brother? Then we, too, will call Him Jesus. "**Jesus, Name all names** above, Jesus best and nearest; Jesus, fount of perfect love, Holiest, tenderest, dearest: Jesus, source of grace completed, Jesus holiest, sweetest; Jesus, Savior all Divine, Thine 's the Name, and only Thine. "

^{...}there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved.

Philippians 2:9 ...God also has highly exalted Him and given Him the **name which is above every name**, 10 that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of those in heaven, and of those on earth, and of those under the earth, 11 and that **every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.**

Jesus born as a babe now at the right hand of the Father in Heaven Holding all things including us together by His power...

Colossians 1:15 He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn over all creation. 16 For by Him all things were created that are in heaven and that are on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers. All things were created through Him and for Him. 17 And He is before all things, and **in Him all things consist**.
