- **Earth is removed:** Every earthly foundation falls apart?
- Mountains fall in ocean: Things we always though were forever gone?

vv1-2 God is Our Refuge/Our Strength...Very Present Help in the Fire of Tribulation

Selah.

When all we know burns...God's presence will be enough

- vv 4-7 The Lord steps in: Kingdom later/Our lives now
 - 1. **Living Water** flows from Temple of God: Kingdom Later/From hearts today

Zechariah 14:8 And in that day it shall be That living waters shall flow from Jerusalem

John 7:38 [We are the Temple of God] He who believes in Me, as the Scripture has said, out of his heart will **flow rivers of living water**.

2. **Jesus' reigns as King:** Kingdom later/In our hearts today

The King steps into the Chaos/Everything Changes...

- vv 6-7 Context: Tribulation...Chaos/Confusion/Disorder
- Nations will rage/Kingdoms will move against the Lord

Psalm 2:1 Why do the nations rage... 2 The kings of the earth set themselves...Against the Lord and against His Anointed, saying, 3 "Let us break Their bonds in pieces And cast away Their cords from us." 4 He who sits in the heavens **shall laugh...**6 "Yet I have **set My King** On My holy hill of Zion."

- What about our current tribulation: Everything that can be shaken is shaken?
- Has God set Jesus as King of our lives?

Chaos becomes Order when God steps into Tribulation
As Jesus takes His Rightful Place on the Throne of Jerusalem/Our hearts

- v 5 God's Promise to Jerusalem/Us?
 - 1. I will dwell in your midst/You shall not be moved
 - 2. I will help you...break of dawn. [Just before losing hope/darkest]
- v 6 Resistance: Nations Raging/Kingdoms Roaring at the...
 - 1. **Inescapable reality** New King was coming
 - 2. **Voice that speaks** has ability to melt the earth [Armageddon]
- v 7 God's Promise to His people: He will deal with our enemies/Our refuge
- v 8 Here He comes to earth...and His works follow
 - 1. He makes earth desolate
 - 2. He makes wars cease
 - 3. He breaks weapons of demons/men

Revelation 19:11 Now I saw heaven opened, and behold, a white horse. And He who sat on him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness He judges and makes war. 12 His eyes were like a flame of fire, and on His head were many crowns. He had a name written that no one knew except Himself. 13 He was clothed with a robe dipped in blood, and His name is called The Word of God. 14 And the armies in heaven, clothed in fine linen, white and clean, followed Him on white horses. 15 Now out of His mouth goes a sharp sword, that with it He should strike the nations. And He Himself will rule them with a rod of iron. He Himself treads the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God. 16 And He has on His robe and on His thigh a name written: KING OF KINGS AND LORD OF LORDS. 17 Then I saw an angel standing in the sun; and he cried with a loud voice, saying to all the birds that fly in the midst of heaven, "Come and gather together for the supper of the great God, 18 that you may eat the flesh of kings, the flesh of captains, the flesh of mighty men, the flesh of horses and of those who sit on them, and the flesh of all people, free and slave, both small and great," 19 And I saw the beast, the kings of the earth, and their armies, gathered together to make war against Him who sat on the horse and against His army. 20 Then the beast was captured, and with him the false prophet who worked signs in his presence, by which he deceived those who received the mark of the beast and those who worshiped his image.  - 3. Lord of hosts is w/us...Reiterates: God of Jacob is our refuge. Selah

Deuteronomy 7:21 You shall not be terrified of them; for the Lord your God, the great and awesome God, is among you.

- v 3 Future Messianic Prophesy
 - 1. Victory over enemies
 - 2. Inheritance
 - **Jews Hope:** Abe's Land...Excellence of Jacob, i.e., Israel/Jerusalem
 - All believer's hope: All that heaven is and earth is not. Reserved!

1 Peter 1:4 ... an inheritance **incorruptible and undefiled** and that does not fade away, **reserved** in heaven for you...

Inheritance Waiting: **Selah Calls for a Shout...Begins to Get Loud**

- v 5 God goes up to battle w/a shout/trumpet
- **v 6-8** Sing praises as Jesus takes His throne

Future City of Our God/King Jesus Christ

There is something about God's Real Estate that binds inhabitants of the city with the city itself and with its King. [NJC]

Revelation 21:1 [New Jerusalem] Now I saw a new heaven and a new earth, for the first heaven and the first earth had passed away. Also there was no more sea. 2 Then I, John, saw the holy city, **New Jerusalem**, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband ...9 [Angel to John] "Come, I will show you the bride, the Lamb's wife." 10 And he carried me away in the Spirit to a great and high mountain, and showed me the great city, the holy Jerusalem, descending out of heaven from God, 11 having the glory of God ...14 Now the wall of the city had twelve foundations, and on them were the names of the **twelve apostles of the Lamb.** [Representing us the Church]

1 Peter 2:5 ... you also, as **living stones**, are being built up a **spiritual house**, a holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ.

- Psalm 48 Speaks of Jerusalem old and new...
 - 1. v 2, 3 City of Great King...God is in her palaces
 - 2. **vv 4-7** Kings of earth no longer seeking a two-state solution. At all
 - 3. **v 8** Jerusalem the indisputable City of our God...**Selah**
- v 9 World will worship Jesus in Jerusalem: Meditate on His lovingkindness
- **v 10** World will finally worship Jesus in exact proportion to His Name/Righteousness

v 11 Inhabitants of Jerusalem will be glad at the final outcome of God's Judgment. After being besieged 23 times, attacked 52 times, and captured/recaptured 44 times...the inhabitants of Jerusalem **will praise God for their city...**

vv 12-13 Walk about Zion And go all around her. Count her towers...Mark well her bulwarks; Consider her palaces that you may tell it to the generation following

v14 ...For this is God forever and ever...He will be our guide Even to death [and after]

False Confidence of the Fool

1 Hear this, all peoples; Give ear, all inhabitants of the world, 2 Both low and high, Rich and poor together. 3 My mouth shall speak wisdom, And the meditation of my heart shall give understanding. 4 I will incline my ear to a proverb; I will disclose my dark saying on the harp. 5 Why should I fear in the days of evil, When the iniquity at my heels surrounds me? 6 Those who trust in their wealth And boast in the multitude of their riches, 7 None of them can by any means redeem his brother, Nor give to God a ransom for him— 8 For the redemption of their souls is costly, And it shall cease forever— 9 That he should continue to live eternally, And not see the Pit. 10 For he sees wise men die; Likewise the fool and the senseless person perish, And leave their wealth to others. 11 Their inner thought is that their houses will last forever, Their dwelling places to all generations; They call their lands after their own names. 12 Nevertheless man, though in honor, does

not remain; He is like the beasts that **perish.** 13 This is the **way of those who are foolish**, And of their posterity who approve their sayings. **Selah** 14 Like sheep they are laid in the grave; Death shall feed on them; The upright shall have dominion over them in the morning; And their beauty shall be consumed in the grave, far from their dwelling. 15 But **God will redeem my soul from the power of the grave, For He shall receive me. Selah** 16 Do not be afraid when one becomes rich, When the glory of his house is increased; 17 For when he dies he shall carry nothing away; His glory shall not descend after him. 18 Though while he lives he blesses himself (For men will praise you when you do well for yourself), 19 He shall go to the generation of his fathers; They shall **never see light**. 20 A man who is in honor, yet does not understand, Is like the beasts that perish.

- vv 1-4 Listen up Everybody in the World...I will let you know a mystery of God
- **v 6-13 Mystery:** Everybody is going to die so be ready
 - 1. **v 6** Why should I fear those who trust in riches?
 - 2. **v 7** Do they have the power to redeem a soul? Mine/theirs?
 - **v 8 I** I know that buying back a soul from death/hell is costly

Job 36:18 Because there is wrath, beware lest [God] take you away with one blow; For a large ransom would not help you avoid it. 19 Will your riches, Or all the mighty forces, **Keep you from distress**?

v 9-11 My ranch/land will last forever.

Psalm 52:7 [Righteous will laugh] "Here is the man who did not make God his strength, But trusted in the abundance of his riches, And strengthened himself in his wickedness."

Proverbs 11:28 He who trusts in his riches will fall, But the righteous will flourish like foliage.

Can't love both God/man. Loving one means hating the other. Period.

Mark 10:23 ... How hard it is for those who have riches to enter the kingdom of God!" 24 And the disciples were astonished at His words. But Jesus answered again and said to them, "Children, how hard it is for those who trust in riches to enter the kingdom of God!

v11-13 The foolish believe the party will never end...Nevertheless it will

Truth? It's all gonna burn. Selah

v 14 Beauty rots away/death feeds on nice clothes [Buried in suit?]

v 15 Psalmist: Trusting in God God will redeem my soul from the power of the grave. He shall receive me

• Ratio of those who die remains **relatively constant 1:1** [Enoch/Elijah free ride]

Psalm 89:48 What man can live and not see death? Can he deliver his life from the power of the grave? Selah

No but Jesus death on the cross can

We will all die/will all be judged. We all sinned/somebody needs to pay **Choice...Jesus or something we have to offer.** What will you offer for your soul?

Matthew 16:26 For what profit is it to a man if he gains the whole world, and loses his own soul? Or **what will a man give** in exchange for his soul?

Luke 12:19 [Rich man] I will say to my soul, "Soul, you have many goods laid up for many years; take your ease; eat, drink, and be merry." '20 But God said to him, 'Fool! This night your soul will be required of you; then whose will those things be which you have provided?'

- v 19 Wicked will never see the Light
- v 20 Many well-dressed honorable yet foolish men/women in hell

Job 4:21 Does not their own excellence go away? They die, even without wisdom.

The body of even the honorable rich man who does not understand the depths of his sin and depravity will perish like an animal even as his souls continues on in hell for eternity. [NJC]

To those of us who know we got nothing/need Jesus God will redeem our soul from the power of the grave...He shall receive us

1 The Mighty One, God the Lord, Has spoken and called the earth From the rising of the sun to its going down. 2 Out of Zion, the perfection of beauty, **God will shine forth**. 3 Our God shall come, and shall not keep silent; A fire shall devour before Him, And it shall be very tempestuous all around Him. 4 He shall call to the heavens from above, And to the earth, that He may judge His people: 5 "Gather My saints together to Me, Those who have made a covenant with Me by sacrifice." 6 Let the heavens declare His righteousness, For God Himself is Judge. **Selah** 7 "Hear, O My people, and I will speak, O Israel, and I will testify against you; I am God, your God! 8 I will not rebuke you for your sacrifices Or your burnt offerings, Which are continually before Me. 9 I will not take a bull from your house, Nor goats out of your folds. 10 For every beast of the forest is Mine, And the cattle on a thousand hills. 11 I know all the birds of the mountains, And the wild beasts of the field are Mine. 12 "If I were hungry, I would not tell you; For the world is Mine, and all its fullness. 13 Will I eat the flesh of bulls, Or drink the blood of goats? 14 Offer to God thanksgiving, And pay your vows to the Most High. 15 **Call upon** Me in the day of trouble; I will deliver you, and you shall glorify Me." 16 But to the wicked God says: "What right have you to declare My statutes, Or take My covenant in your mouth, 17 Seeing you hate instruction And cast My words behind you? 18 When you saw a thief, you consented with him, And have been a partaker with adulterers. 19 You give your mouth to evil, And your tongue frames deceit. 20 You sit and speak against your brother; You slander your own mother's son. 21 These things you have done, and I kept silent; You thought that I was altogether like you; But I will rebuke you, And set them in order before your eyes. 22 "Now consider this, you who forget God, Lest I tear you in pieces, And there be none to deliver: 23 Whoever offers praise glorifies Me; And to him who orders his conduct aright I will show the salvation of God."

• **LORD** YHWH Ever Revealing One. The I AM

IOWs God is speaking/Ready to judge so listen up...Selah

- **vv 7-15** First to His people
 - 1. **vv8-11** Bulls/Goats never did it for Me. BTW I own them all anyway
 - 2. I don't eat flesh/drink blood. Not hungry and if I was I wouldn't ask you

Isaiah 1:11 To what purpose is the multitude of your sacrifices to Me?" Says the Lord. "I have had enough of burnt offerings of rams And the fat of fed cattle. I do not delight in the blood of bulls, Or of lambs or goats.

Hosea 6:6 For I desire mercy and not sacrifice, And the knowledge of God more than burnt offerings.

v15 You can't offer Me anything I don't have...So, Instead of Religious Deeds Call on Me/I will deliver you/This is what brings Me glory

- Salvation is very accessible...
 - 1. Not so high you must jump up to the sky in pride
 - 2. Not so low you have to gravel in dust of false humility

Romans 10:8b "The word is near you, in your mouth and in your heart" [that is, the word of faith which we preach]: 9 that if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved... 13 For "whoever calls on the name of the Lord shall be saved."

Joel 2:32 ... whoever calls on the name of the Lord Shall be saved.

Acts 16:30b ...Sirs, what must I do to be saved?" 31 So they said, "Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and you will be saved...

- **vv 7-15** God spoke first to His people
- vv 16-21 Now speaks to wicked Legalists...

Those using God's Law to enslave people rather than point them to Jesus

1 Timothy 1:7 ...desiring to be teachers of the law, understanding neither what they say nor the things which they affirm. 8 But we know that the law is good **if one uses it lawfully...**

How do we use the law lawfully [rightly]? Not to save but to convict

Romans 3:20 ...by the deeds of the law no flesh will be justified in His sight, for by the law is the **knowledge of sin**.

- **v 16** Don't quote My Law if you're going to use it incorrectly
- **v 17** Cast My Words behind you. Out of context
 - v 18 Command all to keep the law while breaking it yourselves...

Romans 2:17 Indeed you are called a Jew, and rest on the law, and make your boast in God, 18 and know His will, and approve the things that are excellent, being instructed out of the law, 19 and are confident that you yourself are a guide to the blind, a light to those who are in darkness, 20 an instructor of the foolish, a teacher of babes, having the form of knowledge and truth in the law. 21 You, therefore, who teach another, do you not teach yourself? You who preach that a man should not steal, do you steal? 22 You who say, "Do not commit adultery," do you commit adultery? You who abhor idols, do you rob temples? 23 You who make your boast in the law, do you dishonor God through breaking the law? 24 For "the name of God is blasphemed among the Gentiles because of you," as it is written.

• vv19-20 Mouth speaks evil/Slander your brother...

...at the same time laying a trip on everyone else!

Acts 15:10 Now therefore, why do you test God by putting a yoke on the neck of the disciples which neither our fathers nor we were able to bear?

- **v 21** I kept silent by now it's time to judge
- v 21 Thought I was like you. Forgetful. But I'm not.

I am God/you are not. I am Judge and will judge so listen up/learn

Matthew 9:12 ... "Those who are well have no need of a physician, but those who are sick. 13 But go and learn what this means: **'I desire mercy and not sacrifice.'** For I did not come to call the righteous, but sinners, to repentance." 14 Then the disciples of John came to Him, saying, "Why do we and the Pharisees fast often, but Your disciples do not fast?"

• What? There will always be self-righteous legalists. Broad road full of 'em

True Believers are saved by Grace alone though Faith alone in Jesus alone

Luke 18:16 [Apostles stopping kids from coming to Jesus] "Let the little children come to Me, and do not forbid them; for of such is the kingdom of God. 17 Assuredly, I say to you, whoever does not **receive the kingdom of God as a little child** will by no means enter it."
