

I. Marriage and Marriage Supper of the Lamb

- ¹ After these things I heard a loud voice of a great multitude in heaven, saying, "Alleluia! Salvation and glory and honor and power belong to the Lord our God!
 - After these things: After seeing a vision of the fall of Commercial Babylon; i.e. World Economic System:

Revelation 18:1 After these things I saw another angel coming down from heaven, having great authority, and the earth was illuminated with his glory. 2 And he cried mightily with a loud voice, saying, "Babylon the great is fallen, is fallen..."

John again hears a Great Multitude in Heaven:

Revelation 7:9 After these things I looked, and behold, a **great multitude** which no one could number, of all nations, tribes, peoples, and tongues, standing before the throne and before the Lamb, clothed with white robes, with **palm branches in their hands**, ¹⁰ and crying out with a loud voice, saying, "Salvation belongs to our God who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb!" ¹¹ All the angels stood around the throne and the elders and the four living creatures, and fell on their faces before the throne and worshiped God, ¹² saying:

"Amen! Blessing and glory and wisdom, Thanksgiving and honor and power and might, Be to our God forever and ever. Amen."

¹³ Then one of the elders answered, saying to me, **"Who are these** arrayed in white robes, and where did they come from?" ¹⁴ And I said to him, "Sir, you know." So he said to me, "**These are the ones who come out of the great tribulation**, and washed their robes and made them white in the blood of the Lamb.

Great Multitudes followed Jesus at His first coming:

Matthew 14:14 ...when Jesus went out He saw a great multitude; and He was moved with compassion for them, and healed their sick.

Matthew 15:30 ...great multitudes came to Him, having with them the lame, blind, mute, maimed, and many others; and they laid them down at Jesus' feet, and He healed them.

Matthew 21:8 ...a very great multitude spread their clothes on the road; others cut down branches from the trees and spread them on the road.

Mark 14:43 ...immediately, while He was still speaking, Judas, one of the twelve, with a **great multitude with swords and clubs**, came from the chief priests and the scribes and the elders.

Alleluia! "Praise the Lord" hallal = Praise; These attributes belong to the Lord our God:

1. Salvation

Acts 4:12 ...for there is no other name [Jesus] under heaven given among men by which we **must be saved.**"

2. Glory

Isaiah 42:8 I am the LORD, that is My name; And **My glory I will not give to another**, Nor My praise to carved images.

3. Honor

Hebrews 2:9 ...we see Jesus, who was made a little lower than the angels, for the suffering of death **crowned with glory and honor**, that He, by the grace of God, might taste death for everyone.

4. Power

2 Peter 1:16 ...we did not follow cunningly devised fables when we made known to you the **power and coming of our Lord Jesus Christ**, but were eyewitnesses of His majesty.

Mark 9:1 And He said to them, "Assuredly, I say to you that there are some standing here who will not taste death till they see the **kingdom of God present with power**." 2 Now after six days Jesus took Peter, James, and John, and led them up on a high mountain apart by themselves; and **He was transfigured before them.**

² For true and righteous are His judgments, because He has judged the great harlot who corrupted the earth with her fornication; and He has avenged on her the blood of His servants shed by her."

Rational for Great Multitude praise:

True
 Righteous
 Judgments against Falseness/Wickedness

Revelation 19:11 Now I saw heaven opened, and behold, a white horse. And He who sat on him was called **Faithful and True**, and in righteousness He **judges** and makes war.

³ Again they said, "Alleluia! Her smoke rises up forever and ever!"

- Praise the Lord... her [Harlot] smoke rises forever ...and ever
- Those who kept the harlot's false doctrine went into the Tribulation:

Revelation 2:21 ...I gave her time to repent of her sexual immorality, and she did not repent. 22 Indeed I will cast her into a sickbed, and those who commit adultery with her into great tribulation, unless they repent of their deeds. 23 I will kill her children with death, and all the churches shall know that I am He who searches the minds and hearts.

- ⁴ And the twenty-four elders and the four living creatures fell down and worshiped God who sat on the throne, saying, "Amen! Alleluia!"
 - 24 Elders [C.f. Revelation 7:11.12] and Four Living Creatures: Amen! Alleluia:
 "So be it! Praise the Lord!" joining the Great Multitude
- Then a voice came from the throne, saying, "Praise our God, all you His servants and those who fear Him, both small and great!"
 - Voice came from the Throne: Jesus [C.f. Rev: 3:21, 5:13, 7:15,17, 22:3]
 - "Praise God, all His servants, those who fear Him, small and great"
 - Jesus is *directing worship* to the **Father**:

Psalm 22:22 *I will declare Your name to My brethren*; In the midst of the assembly I will praise You.23 You who fear the LORD, praise Him! All you descendants of Jacob, glorify Him, And fear Him, all you offspring of Israel!

John 20:16 Jesus said to her, "Mary!" She turned and said to Him, "Rabboni!" ¹⁷ Jesus said to her, "Do not cling to Me, for I have not yet ascended to My Father; but go to My brethren and say to them, 'I am ascending to **My Father and your Father, and** to **My God and your God.**"

• Father directs worship to the **Son**:

Hebrews 1:5 ...to which of the angels did He ever say: "You are My Son, Today I have begotten You"? And again: "I will be to Him a Father, And He shall be to Me a Son"? 6 But when He again brings the firstborn into the world, He says: "**Let all the angels of God worship Him.**" 7 And of the angels He says: "Who makes His angels spirits And His ministers a flame of fire." 8 But to the Son He says: "**Your throne, O God, is forever** and ever; A scepter of righteousness is the scepter of Your kingdom. 9 You have loved righteousness and hated lawlessness; **Therefore God, Your God, has anointed You** With the oil of gladness more than Your companions."

Hebrews 3:3 ...this One has been counted worthy of more glory than Moses, inasmuch as He who built the house has more honor than the house.

⁶ And I heard, as it were, the **voice of a great multitude**, as the **sound of many waters** and as the sound of **mighty thunderings**, saying, **"Alleluia!** For the **Lord God Omnipotent** reigns!

 Great Multitude agrees with Jesus praise of the Father: "Praise the Lord. The Lord ALL POWERFUL reigns!"

⁷ Let us be glad and rejoice and give Him glory, for the marriage of the Lamb has come, and His wife has made herself ready." ⁸ And to her it was granted to be arrayed in fine linen, clean and bright, for the fine linen is the righteous acts of the saints. ⁹ Then he said to me, "Write: 'Blessed are those who are called to the marriage supper of the Lamb!'" And he said to me, "These are the true sayings of God."

- Let us be glad and rejoice and give Him glory:
 - > The Marriage of the Lamb has come: Intimate relationship with his Bride
 - > His Wife has made herself ready and was granted to be arrayed fine linen
 - > Blessed are those who are called to the Marriage Supper of the Lamb

Oriental Marriage Ceremony: 3 Steps [Jeremiah, Escape the Coming Night, 220]

- 1. Parents of bride and bridegroom **negotiate a marriage contract** usually when the couple is very young. They are now legally married but with no sexual contact for years and much more binding than and engagement today.
 - a) Our Legal Marriage Contract began at **conversion**

Ephesians 5:25 Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ also loved the church and gave Himself for her, ²⁶ that He might sanctify and cleanse her with the washing of water by the word, ²⁷ that He might present her to Himself a glorious church, not having spot or wrinkle or any such thing, but that she should be holy and without blemish. ²⁸ So husbands ought to love their own wives as their own bodies; he who loves his wife loves himself. ²⁹ For no one ever hated his own flesh, but nourishes and cherishes it, just as the Lord *does* the church. ³⁰ For we are members of His body, of His flesh and of His bones. ³¹ "For this reason a man shall leave his father and mother and be joined to his wife, and the two shall become one flesh." ³² This is a great mystery, but **I speak concerning Christ and the church**.

Ephesians 1:13 In Him [Jesus] you also trusted, after you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation; in whom also, having believed, you were sealed with the Holy Spirit of promise...

- **2.** Marriage took place when the bridegroom accompanied by some friends went to the Brides house to **take her back home**
 - a) Marriage begins at the Rapture when the Bridegroom Jesus takes

His Bride the Church to His prepared mansion [New Jerusalem] for **7 Years**.

John 14:1 "Let not your heart be troubled; you believe in God, believe also in Me. ² In My Father's house are many mansions; if *it were* not *so*, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. ³ And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself; that where I am, *there* you may be also.

Ephesians 4:30 ...do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, by whom you were sealed for the day of **redemption**. [Honeymoon]

- **3.** Bridal procession **followed by a Marriage Feast** that would last for days!
 - a) Marriage of the Lamb is in **Heaven**; Marriage Supper is on **Earth** [see chart]

Isaiah: 25:6 And in this mountain The LORD of hosts will make for all people A feast of choice pieces, A feast of wines on the lees, Of fat things full of marrow, Of well-refined wines on the lees. 7 And He will destroy on this mountain The surface of the covering cast over all people, And the veil that is spread over all nations. 8 He will swallow up death forever, And the Lord GOD will wipe away tears from all faces; The rebuke of His people He will take away from all the earth; For the LORD has spoken. 9 And it will be said in that day: "Behold, this is our God; We have waited for Him, and He will save us. This is the LORD; We have waited for Him; **We will be glad and rejoice in His salvation**."

b) **Marriage does involve Israel**: C.f. Matthew 22:1-14, Luke 14:16-25 and also Matthew 25:1-13 as Israel is waiting the return of the Bridegroom **and the Bride** for the Wedding Feast on Earth

Matthew 25:1 "Then the kingdom of heaven shall be likened to ten virgins who took their lamps and went out to meet the bridegroom. 2 Now five of them were wise, and five were foolish. 3 Those who were foolish took their lamps and took no oil with them, 4 but the wise took oil in their vessels with their lamps. 5 But while the bridegroom was delayed, they all slumbered and slept. "And at midnight a cry was heard: 'Behold, the bridegroom is coming; go out to meet him!' 7 Then all those virgins arose and trimmed their lamps. 8 And the foolish said to the wise, 'Give us some of your oil, for our lamps are going out.' 9 But the wise answered, saying, 'No, lest there should not be enough for us and you; but go rather to those who sell, and buy for yourselves.' 10 And while they went to buy, the bridegroom came, and those who were ready went in with him to the wedding; and the door was shut. 11 "Afterward the other virgins came also, saying, 'Lord, Lord, open to us!' 12 But he answered and said, 'Assuredly, I say to you, I do not know you.' 13 "Watch therefore, for you know neither the day nor the hour in which the Son of Man is coming.

NOTE: "Wise" gr. *phronimos* or lit "thoughtful". "Foolish" gr. *moros* or lit "heedless". The foolish virgins demonstrated that they did not really know the Lord by their attitude of indifference towards Him. [Morris, 388]

- Who will be present at the Wedding of the Lamb and His Bride?
 - 1. **Bridegroom** [Christ] and the **Bride** [Church]

2. Invited Guests:

- a) **Israel** [Converted during the Great Tribulation]
- b) **Gentile Saints** who survive the Tribulation
- c) Resurrected Old Testament Saints [Daniel 12:2]

Matthew 8:11 ...I say to you that many will come from east and west, and sit down with **Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob in the kingdom of heaven.**

- > Some will go into the 1000 year reign of Christ in their mortal bodies
- > Those returning with Christ [Church and Resurrected Old Testament Saints] will have immortal bodies
- **Is Israel the also the Bride?** Key Verse: Ephesians 5:25 [see above]
- Israel is known in the Old Testament as the Wife of Jehovah

Jeremiah 3:1 "They say, 'If a man divorces his wife, And she goes from him And becomes another man's, May he return to her again?' Would not that land be greatly polluted? But you have played the harlot with many lovers; Yet return to Me," says the LORD... 14 "Return, O backsliding children," says the LORD; "for I am married to you. I will take you, one from a city and two from a family, and I will bring you to Zion. 15 And I will give you shepherds according to My heart, who will feed you with knowledge and understanding. 16 "Then it shall come to pass, when you are multiplied and increased in the land in those days," says the LORD, "that they will say no more, 'The ark of the covenant of the LORD.' It shall not come to mind, nor shall they remember it, nor shall they visit it, nor shall it be made anymore. 17 "At that time Jerusalem shall be called The Throne of the LORD, and all the nations shall be gathered to it, to the name of the LORD, to Jerusalem. No more shall they follow the dictates of their evil hearts.

• **John the Baptist:** Last of the Old Testament Prophets

Luke 7:28 For I say to you, among those born of women there is not a greater prophet than John the Baptist; but **he who is least in the kingdom of God is greater than he**."

NOTE: Whatever distinctions may exist between the saints of the pre-Abrahamic period, the saints in Israel before Christ, the saints among the Gentiles from Abraham to Christ, the saints of the tribulation, and the saints of the churches from Christ to the rapture (and no doubt these will continue to be identifiable groups even in the ages to come), such distinctions are secondary to the great primary truth that all will be there by virtue of the saving work of Christ and their personal trust in the true Creator God and His provision for salvation. There is only one true God (not one God identified with Israel and one God associated with the church) and that one triune God will be in personal fellowship forever with all the redeemed saints of all the ages. He will dwell with them in the Holy City forever [Morris, 389]

• **Church and Israel:** One for all Eternity

Revelation 21:2 Then I, John, saw the holy city, New Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared as a **bride adorned for her husband**. 3 And I heard a loud voice from heaven saying, "Behold, the tabernacle of God is with men, and **He will dwell**

with them, and they shall be His people. God Himself will be with them and be their God.

Revelation 21:9 Then one of the seven angels who had the seven bowls filled with the seven last plagues came to me and talked with me, saying, "Come, I will show you the bride, the Lamb's wife." ¹⁰ And he carried me away in the Spirit to a great and high mountain, and showed me the great city, the holy Jerusalem, descending out of heaven from God, ¹¹ having the glory of God. Her light was like a most precious stone, like a jasper stone, clear as crystal. ¹² Also she had a great and high wall with twelve gates, and twelve angels at the gates, and names written on them, which are the names of the twelve tribes of the children of Israel: ¹³ three gates on the east, three gates on the north, three gates on the south, and three gates on the west. ¹⁴ Now the wall of the city had twelve foundations, and on them were the names of the twelve apostles of the Lamb.

The Bride: Chosen/Willing or Both

- The Bride has made herself ready: Taking the free gift of Salvation [Free-Will]
- 2. The Bride is **"granted to be arrayed"** i.e. undeserved kindness [**Predestination**]
- Bride-Gowns lavishness or drabness will depend upon obedience to Christ; i.e.
 Judgment Seat of Christ:
- **2 Corinthians 5:10** ...we must all appear before the **judgment seat of Christ**, that each one may receive the things done in the body, according to what he has done, whether **good or bad.**
- **1 Corinthians 3:12** Now if anyone builds on this foundation with gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, straw, 13 each one's work will become clear; for the Day will declare it, because it will be revealed by fire; and the fire will test each one's work, of what sort it is. 14 If anyone's work which he has built on it endures, he will receive a **reward.**

Philippians 3:9 ...and be found in Him, not having my own righteousness, which is from the law, but that which is through **faith in Christ**, the righteousness which is from God by faith...

Ephesians 8:8 For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God, 9 not of works, lest anyone should boast. 10 For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that **we should walk in them**.

¹⁰ And **I fell at his feet to worship him**. But he said to me, "See *that you do* not *do that!* I am your fellow servant, and of your brethren who have the testimony of Jesus. Worship God! For the testimony of **Jesus is the spirit of prophecy."**

 Worship of Angels: "don't do that" I only have the testimony of Jesus; later the same mistake:

Revelation 22:8 Now I, John, saw and heard these things. And when I heard and saw, I fell down to worship before the feet of the angel who showed me these things.

- Jesus is the Spirit of Prophesy: Emphasis on humanity of Jesus in orig. language
- **God becomes Man:** Faithful testimony of this truth was needed throughout history against the spirit of Antichrist, especially now as Antichrist seems to be winning:

1 John 4:1 Beloved, do not believe every spirit, but test the spirits, whether they are of God; because many false prophets have gone out into the world. ² By this you know the Spirit of God: Every spirit that confesses that **Jesus Christ has come in the flesh is of God**, ³ and every spirit that does not confess that Jesus Christ has come in the flesh is not of God. And this is the *spirit* of the Antichrist, which you have heard was coming, and is now already in the world.

1 john 2:22 Who is a liar but he who denies that Jesus is the Christ? He is antichrist who denies the Father and the Son. ²³ **Whoever denies the Son does not have the Father either**; he who acknowledges the Son has the Father also.

II. Christ on a White Horse: Heaven Opened

Now I saw heaven opened, and behold, a white horse. And He who sat on him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness He judges and makes war.

Heaven opened in Chapter 4 to let John in:

Revelation 4:1 After these things I looked, and behold, a door standing open in heaven. And the first voice which I heard was like a trumpet speaking with me, saying, "Come up here, and I will show you things which must take place after this."2 Immediately I was in the Spirit; and behold, a throne set in heaven, and One sat on the throne.

- Here heaven is opened as Jesus exits for earth on a white horse and called:
 - 1. **Faithful:** Finishing the program of God...Sheriff is back!
 - 2. **True:** "I am the way, the **Truth**, and the Life"
- In righteousness He:
 - 1. Judges
 - 2. Makes war

Psalm 29:10 The LORD sat enthroned at the Flood, And the LORD sits as King forever.

¹² His eyes were like a flame of fire, and on His head were many crowns. He had a name written that no one knew except Himself.

Revelation 1:14 His head and hair were white like wool, as white as snow, and His eyes like a flame of fire...

• Judament is in view

NOTE: Not "like a flame" as 1:14, here Jesus eyes "are a flame"

Name no one knew but Himself: Revelation 19 uses Names from 3 of 4 Gospels:

King of Kings Matthew
 Faithful and True Mark
 Word of God John

4. *Jesus? Luke [Son of man]

*McGee

¹³ He was clothed with a robe dipped in blood, and His name is called The Word of God.

Isaiah 63:1 Who is this who comes from Edom, With dyed garments from Bozrah, This One who is glorious in His apparel, Traveling in the greatness of His strength?— " I who speak in righteousness, mighty to save." 2 **Why is Your apparel red**, And Your garments like one who treads in the winepress? 3 " I have trodden the winepress alone, And from the peoples no one was with Me. For I have trodden them in My anger, And trampled them in My fury; Their blood is sprinkled upon My garments...

Genesis 49:9 [Jacob last words to his sons] Judah is a lion's whelp; From the prey, my son, you have gone up. He bows down, he lies down as a lion; And as a lion, who shall rouse him? 10 The scepter shall not depart from Judah, Nor a lawgiver from between his feet, Until Shiloh comes; And to Him shall be the obedience of the people. 11 Binding his donkey to the vine, And his donkey's colt to the choice vine, **He washed his garments in wine, And his clothes in the blood of grapes**. 12 His eyes are darker than wine, And his teeth whiter than milk.

¹⁴ And the **armies in heaven**, clothed in **fine linen**, **white** and **clean**, followed Him on white horses.

Brides location revealed: Heaven now to earth [Rapture] v.7 [also Angels]

Jude 1:14 Now Enoch, the seventh from Adam, prophesied about these men also, saying, "Behold, **the Lord comes with ten thousands of His saints**, 15 to execute judgment on all, to convict all who are ungodly among them of all their ungodly deeds which they have committed in an ungodly way, and of all the harsh things which ungodly sinners have spoken against Him."

15 Now out of **His mouth goes a sharp sword**, that with it He should **strike the nations**. And He Himself will **rule them with a rod of iron**. He Himself **treads the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty**

God.

Isaiah 11:4 But with righteousness He shall judge the poor, And decide with equity for the meek of the earth; He shall strike the earth with the rod of His mouth, And **with the breath of His lips He shall slay the wicked.**

¹⁶ And He has on *His* robe and on His thigh a name written: KING OF KINGS AND LORD OF LORDS.

III. Beast and His Armies Defeated: Supper of our Great God

¹⁷ Then I saw an **angel standing in the sun**; and he cried with a loud voice, saying to all the **birds that fly in the midst of heaven**, "Come and **gather together for the supper of the great God**, ¹⁸ that you may **eat the flesh of kings, the flesh of captains, the flesh of mighty men, the flesh of horses and of those who sit on them, and the flesh of all people, free and slave, both small and great."**

Angel "standing in the sun": Previous angel "in charge" of the sun?

Revelation 16:8 Then the fourth angel *poured out his bowl on the sun*, and power was given to him to scorch men with fire. 9 And men were scorched with great heat, and they blasphemed the name of God who has power over these plagues; and they did not repent and give Him glory.

- Second "Supper" chronologically before the Marriage Supper
- **Eat the flesh** of all rebelling "earth dwellers"; i.e. Kings, Captains, Mighty, Horses, ALL PEOPLE, free/slave, small/great

Zephaniah 1:7 Be silent in the presence of the Lord GOD; For the day of the LORD *is* at hand, For the LORD has **prepared a sacrifice**; **He has invited His guests**.

People will not have to guess that Jesus is back:

Matthew 24:26 "Therefore if they say to you, 'Look, He is in the desert!' do not go out; or 'Look, He is in the inner rooms!' do not believe it. 27 For as the lightning comes from the east and flashes to the west, so also will the coming of the Son of Man be. 28 For wherever the carcass is, there the eagles will be gathered together.

NOTE: Similar to but *not* Ezekiel 39:17-20

¹⁹ And I saw the **beast, the kings of the earth, and their armies**, gathered together to **make war against Him who sat on the horse** and **against His army**.

Psalm 2:1 Why do the nations rage, And the people plot a vain thing? 2 The kings of the

earth set themselves, And the rulers take counsel together, Against the LORD and against His Anointed, saying,3 "Let us break Their bonds in pieces And cast away Their cords from us." 4 He who sits in the heavens shall laugh; The Lord shall hold them in derision. 5 Then He shall speak to them in His wrath, And distress them in His deep displeasure...

Against His [Jesus] Army: C.f. Jude 14,15

Then the **beast was captured**, and with him the **false prophet** who worked signs in his presence, by which he deceived those who received the mark of the beast and those who worshiped his image. **These two were cast alive into the lake of fire burning with brimstone.**

- Beast [Antichrist] and False-Prophet captured
- False Prophet:
 - a) Worked signs / wonders in the presence in the presence of the Beast
 - b) Deceived those who received the Mark
 - c) Deceived those who worshipped the image
- Antichrist and the False Prophet: First to be cast into hell...ever
- Cast alive into the Lake of Fire; Literal? Does it matter? Forever and ever

²¹ And the rest were killed with the **sword which proceeded from the mouth of Him** who sat on the horse. And all the birds were filled with their flesh.

Hebrews 4:12 ...the word of God is living and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and of joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.

Ephesians 6:17 ...take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God;

- Satan has abandoned Antichrist at this point and is not cast into hell...yet
- Those killed by the Word of God will be raised from the dead when all other lost are raised. **Afterward they will be cast into hell:**

Revelation 20:11 Then I saw a great white throne and Him who sat on it, from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away. And there was found no place for them. 12 And I saw the dead, small and great, standing before God, and books were opened. And another book was opened, which is the Book of Life. And the dead were judged according to their works, by the things which were written in the books. 13 The sea gave up the dead who were in it, and Death and Hades delivered up the dead who were in them. And they were judged, each one according to his works. 14 Then Death and Hades were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death. 15 And anyone not found written in the Book of Life was cast into the lake of fire.
