Discussion Guide — No Condemnation

Main Idea

This was Week One of “In Christ Alone,” and Pastor Matt started it with one of the greatest revelations from Jesus’ sacrifice: if we are in Christ....Many Christians struggle with insecurity in their faith, but if you are in Christ, you can have assurance that one day you will be with Him. We don’t struggle knowing if we are married or not, but we sometimes struggle knowing that we are “in Christ.” Everyone must have a moment where we make the decision to follow Him. Especially in the South, everyone is nice, but being nice doesn’t mean that you actually have a relationship with Jesus. Being in Christ, means receiving the grace (not earned) from Jesus’ sacrifice.
