

Discussion Guide - The Choice is Yours

Main Idea

Continuing on in Week Ten of the Sermon on the Mount series, Pastor Matt challenged us all with Jesus' passage on the narrow path. Jesus makes it clear that there are two paths in life. The first one is wide, heavily travelled, but leads to destruction. The second is the narrow path, which only few find, but for those that do, it leads to eternal life. Hearing everything in the Sermon on the Mount has lead us to this climactic choice for all of us. Will we choose the wide path, or the narrow path? We must make the choice now, because we won't have a chance once we die:

Make It Practical

- Your Spirit Instantly Departs From Your Body
- Your Spirit Is Present With Jesus In Paradise (Believer)
- Your Spirit Is Conscious In A Place Void Of God (Non-Believer)
- Your Body And Spirit Will Be United
- You Will Face The Judgement Seat Of Christ

- 3. Why does it seem easier to follow the wide path? Why do you think it's so enticing?
- 4. What changes do you need to implement to stay on the narrow path in your life?
