How to Live a Legacy Life

Big Idea

So many people ask why they are on this planet; and they want to know how to make a difference in this world. We all want to make an impact for what matters the most. We leave a legacy when we make our lives about others, instead of ourselves. This year's legacy season will shape the coming years:

You crown the year with a bountiful harvest; even the hard pathways overflow with abundance. Psalm 65:11

To live a legacy life, we must **pray**, **give** and **go**! This lifestyle **takes faith**; we must see the future. It also **takes sacrifice**; we must choose to sacrifice for the future that we see. It **takes generosity**, where we take ourselves from giving 1.0 up to the next level of giving 2.0. And lastly it **takes urgency**, because it must happen today!

Discussion Questions

2. When you see a stranger in need, do you tend to avoid them, like the priest and levite in the good Samaritan parable, or do you show compassion and help them like the Samaritan? (Be Honest)
3. Would you consider yourself a 1.0 giver (See a need, meet a need) or a 2.0 giver (Planned, percentage, priority giver) or both?
4. What is your plan to fund your local church? If you don't have a plan what actions do you need to take to create a plan?
5. Have you had an opportunity to use your random acts of kindness card? If so, how did you use it?

Prayer Focus

This week's prayer focus is for guidance in living a legacy life. What are the things that you need to change to begin living like this? With God's Spirit, we can encounter the legacy lifestyle He has for us.
