Discussion Guide - Ephesians 6:10-24 - Imitators of God

Main Idea

This week, Pastor Chris taught us in the final week of our Ephesians series. As followers of Jesus, we are not immune to the things that happen in this world, but we realize that the battles we face are not of flesh and blood, but of evil spiritual forces. Paul, the writer of Ephesians, tells us to put on the Armor of God in order to stand strong against the devil's schemes to cause us to fall. As we put on each piece of armor, we remember that it's God who ultimately protects us, as we learn how to fight His ways.

 - Breastplate of Righteousness
 - Shoes of Peace
 - Shield of Faith
 - Helmet of Salvation
 - Sword of the Spirit
- 4. What part does prayer play in the armor of God (vv.18-20)?
- 5. What is your biggest takeaway from the book of Ephesians?
