



Discussion Guide — Keep Knocking

Main Idea

During this week of “Let Us Pray,” Pastor Chris taught us to be persistent in our prayer lives. There may have been things that we have been praying for during our 21 days of prayer and fasting, but we have not quite seen God come through for us. That is not a sign to give up praying, for Jesus teaches us in two stories to become persistent. We must keep knocking and never give up. Keep asking, keep seeking, and those things that we are praying in the will of God will be answered.

Make It Practical

- Ask - Make your prayer requests known to God
- Seek - Use spiritual eyes to see how God might be moving in your situation
- Knock - Take opportunities to act, in faith, when you see how God might be moving

2. When it seems that God is absent or silent in your prayer life, what do you do?

4. Why do you think that Jesus wants us to become persistent in our prayer lives?
5. What is one practical way that you become more persistent in your prayers?
