

Discussion Guide - My Only Aim

Main Idea

Pastor Matt kicked off this series, "My Verse", with his own life verse from Acts 20:24. In this series, we want you to pursue God's Word for what He may speak to you. It might not come to you over night, but as you spend more time hearing God speak, He will lead you to a specific verse of scripture to speak life into you. Preaching from his verse, Pastor Matt taught us that our only aim in life should be to know God and make Him know:

Make It Practical

- I must be Holy Spirit led
- · I don't have to have it all figured out
- I will face hardships & persecution
- · My life is not about me
- I have only one aim
