



Message Title: If You Say So I Will

Date: August 31st, 2025

SCRIPTURE

Read Luke 5:1–11 together.

DISCUSSION

1. ONE DAY (v.1)

- The story begins with “One day...” It was just an ordinary day for most people, but for Peter, James, and John, it became the day everything changed.
 - *When was your “One Day” with Jesus — a moment when your life was forever changed by Him?*

2. MOVEMENT & OBEDIENCE (vv.2–5)

- Jesus steps into Peter’s boat and asks him to push out a little. Then He asks Peter to go deeper and let down the nets.
- Peter’s response: *“Because you say so, I will.”*
- *Where might Jesus be asking you to take a step of faith or move beyond your comfort zone?*



- *What does “Because you say so” obedience look like in your life right now?*

3. GOD’S POWER AT WORK (vv.6–9)

- The miracle of overflowing nets left Peter awestruck. He immediately recognized his own unworthiness before Jesus.
 - *When have you experienced God’s presence or provision in a way that left you in awe?*
 - *Do we still pause long enough to be “awestruck” by God, or have we grown numb to His blessings?*

4. A NEW CALLING (vv.10–11)

- Jesus gave Peter a new mission: “From now on you will fish for people.” They left everything immediately to follow Him.
 - *How does following Jesus reshape our priorities and purpose?*
 - *What might God be calling you to “leave behind” in order to follow Him more fully?*

GOING DEEPER – COMMUNITY & DISCIPLESHIP



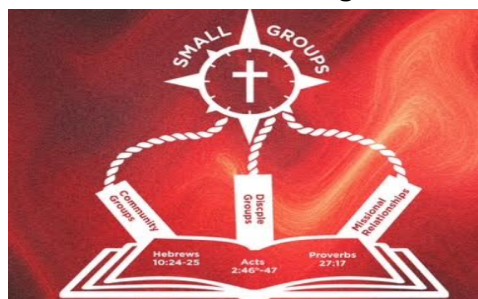
- Peter wasn't called alone. James and John went with him. Following Jesus has always been a community calling.
- *Why is community so vital to spiritual growth?*
- *Which kind of relationships (community group, disciple group, missional friendship) do you need most in this season?*

SCRIPTURE TO REMEMBER

Matthew 28:19–20 – *"Therefore, go and make disciples..."*

ACTION STEPS

1. Identify one area this week where you can say: *"Because You say so, I will."*
2. Pray about your role in community this semester. Is God nudging you to join — or even lead — a small group?
3. Take one step of obedience toward the calling Jesus has placed on your life.

- Share prayer requests.
 - Pray together, asking for courage to respond in obedience like Peter, and for deeper community as disciples of Jesus.
