Discussion Guide — Wise Builders

Main Idea

At the end of the Sermon on the Mount, Jesus shares that listening to His words and doing what He says is like a wise builder, whose house will never be shaken. Pastor Chris taught us that too often we build our lives on the whatever we find in this life. Maybe it's money, relationships, style, toys, hard work, or even where we live. When the storms come, these are not able to withstand them and end in our lives crashing down. Instead, we should go all in and become obedient to Jesus' teachings.
