

Discussion Guide — How to Pray With Power

Main Idea

Pastor Matt taught us in this week of "Let Us Pray," a great model of prayer that Jesus gave to His disciples. Ever wondered how to pray effectively? You are in great company, so did Jesus' disciples. "The secret of prayer is prayer in secret." When we learn how to pray effectively through this model, we will begin to see God moving in our prayer lives. But it takes us first realizing this isn't a time where we get God on our page, but instead, we get on His page!

Make It Practical

- Begin your prayers with God's praise
- Wanting God's <u>purpose</u> in this world
- Asking for God's provision for the day for ourselves and others
- · Receiving God's pardon, as we are pardoning others
- Seeking God's protection from the enemy's tactics
- And finishing our prayers with God's praise for what He will do
