Discussion Questions

1. Faith Requires a Dream

Read Hebrews 11:1



"Now faith is confidence in what we hope for and assurance about what we do not see."

Discussion:

- What stood out to you most from this passage?
 - Why do you think dreaming is connected to faith?
 - What is one area of your life where you are currently trusting God for something you cannot accomplish on your own?
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2. Vision Gives Life Purpose

Read Proverbs 29:18

Without God's vision, it's easy to drift through life. Vision gives direction, motivation, and purpose.

Discussion:

- Have you ever experienced a season where you felt like you were simply maintaining instead of pursuing God's purpose?
 - How does having a clear vision affect your daily decisions?
 - What keeps people from dreaming with God?
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3. Which Dream Describes You?

The sermon identified four unhealthy places we can find ourselves:

- **No Dream** – Comfortable but coasting.



- **Wrong Dream** – Busy doing something that isn't truly fulfilling.
- **Dying Dream** – Discouraged because of delays or obstacles.
- **Vague Dream** – A dream exists but lacks clarity and specificity.

Discussion:

- Which of these four best describes your current season?
 - Why do you think you're there?
 - What would need to change to move toward God's vision?
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Habakkuk's Five Steps to Pursuing God's Dream

1. Make Room

Read Habakkuk 2:1 & Jeremiah 33:3

God often speaks in moments of stillness.

Discussion:

- What distracts you most from hearing God's voice?
- What practical changes could help you create more space for prayer and listening this week?
- How can our upcoming 21 Days of Prayer & Fasting help position us to hear from God?



Challenge This Week

Spend at least 15 minutes each day without your phone, simply praying, listening, and asking God what He wants to show you.

2. See It

Read Habakkuk 2:1 & Matthew 9:36

Before Jesus acted, He saw.

Discussion:

- What burden or opportunity has God been showing you lately?
 - What do you believe God wants to do in your family, career, ministry, or community?
 - How can exposing yourself to what God is doing through other churches or ministries expand your vision?
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3. Write the Vision

Read Habakkuk 2:2

Dreams become clearer when they're written down.

Activity

Take five quiet minutes.

Write answers to these prompts:

- What dream has God placed in my heart?



- Why does this matter?
- Who benefits if this dream becomes reality?
- What would success look like?
- What would require God to show up?

If comfortable, share with your group.

4. Run Toward It

Dreams rarely begin with perfect conditions.

Discussion:

- What's one small step you can take this week toward your dream?
 - What's keeping you from taking that first step?
 - Have you ever experienced God providing after you stepped out in faith?
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5. Don't Give Up

Read Habakkuk 2:3

God's timing is often different from ours.

Discussion:

- Why is waiting one of the hardest parts of following God?
- Which example from the sermon (Michael Jordan, Walt Disney, Dr. Seuss, etc.) encouraged you the most?



- How can this group help you remain faithful while you wait?
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Personal Reflection

Spend a few quiet moments asking the Holy Spirit:

- What dream have I stopped believing for?
- Where have I become comfortable?
- What is God inviting me to pursue again?
- What step of faith do I need to take this week?
