The Anatomy of A Storm

Matt 14:22-33

Summary:

Don't Study the Storm, Study the Savior

1. Read Matthew 14:22-33 & Mark 4:35-41

- a) Share your observation of Matthew 14:24 and Matt 14:32.
- b) Share your observation of the Storm in Matthew 14 & the Storm in Mark 4. (Notice that in both storms, Jesus gave the disciples a similar mission – cross over to the other side) What are the differences in these storms. Why do you think Jesus responded to both the storms differently?
- c) What lesson do you think Jesus is wanting the disciples to learn about Him?

Note: We know the Mission, so often we serve without knowing the MAN. Burnout, disappointment, Hurt, Difficulty... We focused on the Mission (we glorified it) but not the man Jesus. But the Storm has Moved them from:

- *Wondering to Worshipping*
- *Confusion to Confession*
- *Fear to Faith.*

2. The Storm is the Teacher, but Jesus is the Lesson (v22-24)

- a) Where does Storms originate?
- b) Purpose of the storms differs depending on who the originator is. Suggest the purpose of the storms based on the source?
- c) What will keep you going for the long haul in the storm with your new revelation that Jesus is the lesson?

3. Storms don't diminish the divinity of Christ but display it. (V25)

If someone who's struggling with anxiety, worries or slight insomnia, how would you encourage and journey with the individual with the above truth? (Break into smaller group sharing and prepare a role play to present to everyone. You can take 5 minutes for this segment)

4. *Share a personal take away / paradigm shift from the sermon. (I'm sure you will hear a different revelation from different ones and receive new revelations of Jesus)*
