

## Cell Study for 27<sup>th</sup> February - God's Grace for Gospel Beauticians

Titus Sermon 5: Titus 2:11-15

1. Read Titus 2:11-15.

a) Identify the Work of Grace in these verses

- i. **Appearance** of God's Grace (v11)
- ii. **Instruction** of God's Grace (v12)
- iii. **Transformation** of God's Grace (v13)
- iv. **Generosity** of God's Grace (v14)
- v. **Authority** of God's Grace (v15)

b) Among the Work of Grace above which one do you relate to the most? Why?  
(own answer)

2. a. Pastor Sam shared about the Transformation of Grace. How does the transformation take place?

**Answer:** Verse 13 points us to the Blessed Hope—Christ and His promised return.

- Jesus came the first time to save the soul of man; He will come a second time to resurrect the body
- Jesus came the first time and was judged by men; He will come a second time to a coronation.
- Jesus came the first time to a tree; He will come a second time to a throne.
- Jesus came the first time and stood before Pilate; He will come a second time and Pilate will stand before Him.

b. Invite everyone to pause and reflect quietly: “What is one way I can behold Christ daily in 2026?” Encourage them to think of something practical—prayer, scripture, worship, serving, or obedience.

c. Pair up in two sharing - Turn to the person next to them and share their reflection in one sentence. Example: “I will behold Christ daily by starting each morning with scripture.” After sharing, pray for each other to experience the Grace that will help us Behold Christ daily through the ups and downs of 2026.

3. Read Titus 2:15 aloud as a group.

In your own words, share how you can live out and exercise the authority of God's grace in your daily life during this season. **(Own Answer)**
