Pr Sabrina Loh - Conquering the high places

Introduction:

Pr Sabrina Loh spoke about the need to conquer the high places. There is something about high places - one of God's name is the Lord Most High, in any military battle all soldier would want to fight from higher ground, in the spiritual context God also calls us to occupy these "high places". She spoke about the 3 high places we need to take: i) mind ii) family structure iii) nations. Pr Sabrina ends by sharing how we can achieve this: i) by His divine grace ii) By being bold to declare what He declares iii) By being connected to the body of Christ

1. The first high place we are called to conquer is the mind. Read Isaiah 55:8-9
 - a) Are our ways (and thoughts) aligned with God's?
 - b) Why is it important to align our ways (and thoughts) to God's
 - c) Discuss the difference between renewing vs emptying our mind
2. The second high place we are called to conquer is the family structure. Read 2 Timothy 1:5
 - a) Who are the 2 people named in the verses?
 - b) What are some behaviors that you are practicing/seen practice in your family? Do you believe all these behaviors are good?
 - c) Discuss why it is important to be conscious about the type of behaviors we are practicing in our family?
3. The third high place we are called to conquer is the nations (Refer Isaiah 2:2)
 - a) What are the 7 "mountains" of culture mentioned in the sermon?
 - b) What does it mean to take the high places of one of the "cultures" above?
4. Which of these 3 high places do you feel called to bring change to? Surrender this area to God, partner up and pray for one another.
