Allowing God to Use Us to Bring 5 People to Christ

“And the Lord added to the church daily such as should be saved.” — *Acts 2:47*

THE VISION

God desires to use *ordinary believers* to do *extraordinary kingdom work*. The Fairfield 5×5 Faith Initiative is a simple, Spirit-led commitment for every member to allow God to work **through them** to bring **five people to Christ**—not by pressure, but by **presence, prayer, and purpose**.

THE GOAL

Each Fairfield member prayerfully commits to:

- **Identify 5 people**
 - **Intercede for them**
 - **Invest in them**
 - **Invite them**
 - **Introduce them to Christ**

THE 5×5 FAITH PROCESS

1. IDENTIFY (Write the Vision)

“Write the vision and make it plain.” — Habakkuk 2:2

Prayerfully identify **five people** God has placed in your life:

- Family members
- Friends
- Co-workers
- Neighbors
- Classmates

 **Action Step:**

Write their first names only (for privacy).

2. INTERCEDE (Cover Them in Prayer)

“Pray without ceasing.” — 1 Thessalonians 5:17

Commit to praying for your five:

- Daily or weekly
- For open hearts
- For divine opportunities
- For courage and wisdom for yourself

Suggested Prayer:

“Lord, prepare their hearts, open doors for conversation, and use me as Your vessel.”

3. INVEST (Build Genuine Relationships)

“Let us not love in word or talk but in deed and in truth.” — 1 John 3:18

Evangelism begins with **relationship**, not a script.

Ways to Invest:

- Check on them
- Celebrate their milestones
- Show compassion in hard times
- Be consistent and authen

Reminder:

People don’t care how much you know until they know how much you care.

4. INVITE (Create the Opportunity)

“Come and see.” — John 1:46

Extend an invitation:

- Worship service
- Bible study
- Community event
- Special church celebration

Simple Invite Script:

“I’d love for you to come to church with me this Sunday. It would mean a lot.”

5. INTRODUCE (Let God Do the Saving)

“One plants, another waters, but God gives the increase.” — 1 Corinthians 3:6

Your role is obedience—**God handles conversion.**

Ways to introduce them to Christ:

- Share your testimony
- Pray with them
- Encourage them to accept Christ
- Connect them with a ministry leader

Key Truth:

You are a witness, not the Savior.

THE ROMAN ROAD TO SALVATION

Step 1: All Have Sinned

Romans 3:23

“For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God.”

Truth: Everyone needs salvation—no one is excluded or singled out.

Step 2: Sin Has a Cost

Romans 6:23a

“For the wages of sin is death...”

Truth: Sin separates us from God spiritually and eternally.

Step 3: God Offers a Gift

Romans 6:23b

“...but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.”

Truth: Salvation is a gift, not something we earn.

Step 4: Christ Died for Us

Romans 5:8

“But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.”

Truth: God loved us before we ever loved Him.

Step 5: Respond in Faith

Romans 10:9–10

“That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved.”

Truth: Salvation requires belief and confession—not perfection.

Step 6: Call on the Lord

Romans 10:13

“For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.”

Truth: Salvation is available to *whosoever*.

A SIMPLE PRAYER OF SALVATION

(Offer only if the person is ready—never pressure)

“Lord Jesus, I know that I am a sinner and need Your forgiveness.
I believe You died for my sins and rose again.
I turn from my sin and place my trust in You.
Come into my life and be my Lord and Savior.
Amen.”

AFTER THE CONVERSATION

- Celebrate obedience, not outcomes
 - Encourage baptism and discipleship
 - Connect them to Fairfield ministries
 - Continue a relationship and prayer

THE FAIRFIELD COMMITMENT

(Members may recite or sign)

“I commit to allowing God to use me to reach five people for Christ.
I will pray, invest, invite, and trust God for the increase.
I surrender my fear, excuses, and comfort for Kingdom purpose.
Here I am, Lord—send me.”
