A DIVINE REASSURANCE OF RESTORATION

Twenty-five years into Israel's captivity, fourteen years after the fall of Jerusalem and her temple, the LORD took hold of Ezekiel and in a vision from God, Ezekiel was spiritually transported to the land of Israel and set upon a very high mountain. From there Ezekiel could see toward the south what appeared to be a city where he saw a man whose face shone like bronze standing beside a gateway entrance. That man was holding in his hand a linen measuring cord and a measuring rod. He said to Ezekiel, "Son of man, watch and listen. Pay close attention to everything I show you. You have been brought here so I can show you many things. Then you will return to the people of Israel and tell them everything you have seen."
