## THE METICULOUS NATURE OF GOD'S PLANS

Ezekiel's being shown by God a vision of the new temple in chapter 40 is here continued in chapter 41. Ezekiel's guide leads him into the inner sanctuary and the Most Holy Place. The angel measures the walls, doorway, and the room; he then measures the temple's side rooms, each with precise dimensions and arranged on three levels. The construction details, including the supporting pillars; then the measurements of a building to the west of the main temple. The chapter concludes with measurements and descriptions of the outer sanctuary and entrances; and the detailed carvings of cherubim and palm trees upon the doors and walls.
