## Sacred Life Genesis 1:26-28 Why is Life Sacred?

- Life is sacred because it was created by God.
  - To be created means to be endowed with value and meaning from the Creator.
    - This is true of all of creation.
    - God endorses his creation when he blesses it.
    - Human life is sacred because God made human beings in a special way.
  - Humans have been created by God in a personal way.
    - Humans have been created in the image of God and in the likeness of God.
- To bear God's image and likeness means:
  - Humans are God's representatives on earth.
    - Humans are designed for relationship.
    - Humans are intelligent and communal.
    - Humans are moral.
    - Humans are creative.
- Humans have been created to express the diversity and plurality of the Triune God.
  - This means that both man and woman have a shared dignity and value.
    - This means that gender and sexuality are good and essential to God's created order.
- Human life is sacred because God made human beings to have a special position.
  - God has called humanity to have dominion over the earth.
    - This means that humans were meant to exercise loving authority over creation.
- Human life is sacred because human beings get to participate in the creative work of God.
- In blessing humanity with His call to "be fruitful and multiply," God is encouraging us to be pro-creative beings.
  - Thus, this is a call for us to be people who promote life of all kinds and the flourishing of life on earth.
