 - The people we are called to love is determined by proximity not preference.
 - Our love for people is often inconvenient.
 - Our love for people is always sacrificial.
 - Our love for people requires our whole being.
 - It is born from spiritual conviction.
 - It is fueled by emotional connection.
 - It is carried out in physical action.
 - The conviction to love turns us into neighbors.
