- The church has been called to courage.
- We must consider how to stir one another up.
- We must stir one another up to love.
 - Our love must be made concrete by good works.
 - The term used for stirring up is a strange word in the Greek.
- It can be used positively (as it is in this case), and it can be used negatively (to provoke or have a sharp disagreement).
- We must consider our commitment to one another.
- We must consider our habits (good or bad) because habits form us.
 - Habits also show where our desires are.
 - There is a reciprocal relationship between our loves and our habits.
- We must consider together how to keep on keeping on.
- While we have a faith that looks back in time to what Jesus has done, we still look forward to what Jesus will do.
 - Galatians 6:9 And let us not grow weary of doing good, for in due season we will reap, if we do not give up.
