





GO AND GATHER

In this parable, Jesus is describing the shift from Israel being God's people, to the world through Christ. The end of this parable will show that you must be dressed with the robe of Christ to enter the kingdom of heaven.

- My focus is on the King's servants. They were instructed to GO and gather ALL people.

There are no exceptions to who gets to share Christ, where it is shared, or who gets to hear it.



18 And Jesus came and said to them, “All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. 19 Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, 20 teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age.”

WHO?

- Jesus doesn't just say 1 person go and make disciples. We ALL are to make disciples everywhere we go.
- Go into ALL the world

- we are Christians, disciples, ambassadors/missionaries
- You are in full time ministry



IT'S A FULL-TIME JOB!
