Big Idea

Faith Is Often Passed Down Quietly

Read Together: *2 Timothy 1:5* — I am reminded of your sincere faith, which first lived in your grandmother Lois and in your mother Eunice...

- What stands out to you about the faith of Lois and Eunice?
- Why can quiet, consistent faith sometimes feel overlooked?
- Who has helped shape your faith through their example?
- How can everyday faithfulness impact future generations?

God Uses Ordinary People

Read Together: *1 Corinthians 1:27–29* — God chose the foolish things of the world to shame the wise...

- Why do you think God often works through ordinary, unnoticed people?
- Have you ever struggled to believe your life could make a spiritual impact? Why?
- What does this passage teach us about how God sees influence and significance?
- Where might God already be using you in ways you don't fully realize?

Faithfulness Matters More Than Perfection

Read Together: *Deuteronomy 6:6–7* — These commandments that I give you today are to be on your hearts. Impress them on your children...

- What does this passage teach us about building faith into everyday life?
- Why can consistency matter more than perfection when influencing others?
- What are simple ways we can model faith to the people around us?
- How might God use small moments of faithfulness over time?



Practical Steps

- Encourage someone younger in their faith with a text, conversation, or prayer.
- Share a story of God's faithfulness with a family member or friend.
- Spend a few minutes praying for the next generation.
- Look for one ordinary moment this week where you can model kindness, patience, or faith.
