Cosmic Prophecies — Week 2: The Lamb in the Sky

## Big Idea

Long before Jesus went to the cross, God was already revealing His rescue plan through stories in Scripture. In Genesis 22, Abraham's willingness to offer Isaac points forward to a greater sacrifice — the Lamb God Himself would provide. God's plan of redemption was never an afterthought; it has been woven into His story from the beginning.

## Discuss

### ***Faith That Trusts God***

**Read Together:** *Genesis 22:1–2* — Sometime later God tested Abraham... 'Take your son, your only son, whom you love—Isaac...'

- What part of Abraham's story in this passage stands out to you the most?
- Why do you think trusting God can feel hardest when we don't understand what He's doing?
- How do you normally respond when God asks you to trust Him with something important?
- What might it look like to trust God even when the outcome is uncertain?

### ***God Will Provide***

**Read Together:** *Genesis 22:7–8* — Isaac asked, 'Where is the lamb for the burnt offering?' Abraham answered, 'God himself will provide the lamb.'

- Why is Abraham's response to Isaac so powerful in this moment?
- What does this passage reveal about Abraham's understanding of God's character?
- When have you experienced God providing in a way you didn't expect?
- How might believing 'God will provide' change the way we face uncertainty?

### ***The Greater Lamb***

**Read Together:** *John 1:29* — Look, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world!

- What similarities do you notice between the story of Abraham and Isaac and the story of Jesus?
- Why do you think God used this story centuries earlier to point forward to Jesus?
- How does understanding Jesus as the 'Lamb of God' deepen your appreciation for the cross?
- What does this reveal about how long God has been working out His rescue plan?



## Practical Steps

- Spend time reading Genesis 22 and reflect on what it reveals about God's character.
- Write down one area of your life where you need to trust that 'God will provide.'
- Thank God each day this week for one specific way He has already provided in your life.
- Share with someone a story of when you experienced God's faithfulness.

What is one step you will take this week to trust God more deeply?

## Apply It

**Reflection Moment:** One area where I need to trust that God will provide is \_\_\_\_\_.

**Action Step:** Choose one practice above and intentionally do it before your next group meeting.

**Pray Together:** Thank God for His faithfulness and for providing Jesus as the Lamb who takes away sin.

### Leader Reminder
