Cosmic Prophecies — Week 1: In a Galaxy Far Away

Big Idea

Long before Jesus came to earth, God was already telling His story — and even creation points to Him. Before the world began, God planned to love, rescue, and bring us into His family through Jesus.

WARM UP

What's something in nature or in the night sky that fills you with awe or wonder? Why do you think it affects you that way?

DISCUSS

CREATION & WONDER

Read Psalm 19:1 together: “The heavens declare the glory of God; the skies proclaim the work of His hands.”

- What do you notice about how creation points beyond itself to God?
- Why do you think awe and wonder can open our hearts to trust God?
- What’s the difference between being impressed by creation and being drawn to the Creator?

BEFORE THE BEGINNING

Read Ephesians 1:4–5; John 17:24. Notice the phrase “before the creation of the world.”

- What does it mean to you that God’s love and plan existed before anything was created?
- How does this change the way you view God’s response to human brokenness?
- When life feels uncertain, how could remembering God’s long-term plan bring peace?

JESUS AT THE CENTER

Read Colossians 1:16–17; John 1:1–3. Notice how central Jesus is to creation and history.

- How does seeing Jesus as central to God’s story reshape your faith?
- Where do you most need to trust that God is bigger than what you can currently see?
- What questions or curiosities does this message stir in you as this series begins?



PRACTICAL STEPS

Choose one way to intentionally reflect on God's bigger story this week:

- Spend time outside and thank God for something specific you observe in creation.
- Read one scripture from today's discussion and reflect on what it reveals about God.
- Write down one fear you're carrying and one truth from Scripture that speaks to it.

What is one simple step you can take this week to deepen your trust in God's story?

1. Reflection Moment

Choose one practical step above and commit to it before your next group meeting.

3. Pray Together
