12. If I am being COMPLETELY honest with myself, what decision do I really want to make?
13. Which path gives my soul the most peace?
14. Are there any doors that God is trying to shut or open that I might be missing?
15. If money or time were not involved, what choice would I make?
16. How will this decision impact my relationships with other people?
17. Which decision gives me more quality time with my family and for myself?
18. Will one decision give me more knowledge and experience for my future dreams?
19. What is my gut telling me?
20. If both decisions were 99% the same (friends, money, house, etc), is there a 1% key factor that would cause me to choose one over the other?
