## Big Idea

From the beginning of creation to the smallest details of our bodies, everything points to Jesus. The cross was never plan B — it has always been God’s plan to bring us back to Himself. When we step back and see the full picture, we’re invited not just to understand it, but to stand in awe and trust Him.

## Discuss

### ***Jesus Holds It All Together***

**Read Together:** *Colossians 1:16–17* — All things have been created through him and for him... in him all things hold together.

- What stands out to you about the idea that everything was created through and for Jesus?
- How does it change your perspective to think that Jesus is holding everything together right now?
- Where in your life do you feel like things are falling apart, and how might this truth speak into that?
- What helps you trust that God is in control when you can't see the full picture?

### ***The Cross Was Always the Plan***

**Read Together:** *Colossians 1:19–20* — Through him to reconcile to himself all things... by making peace through his blood, shed on the cross.

- Why is it important to understand that the cross was always part of God's plan?
- What does this reveal about God's love and intention toward us?
- How does knowing Jesus chose the cross change the way you see Him?
- Where do you need to be reminded that God is working a bigger plan than you can see?

### ***Our Response to the Wonder***

**Read Together:** *Hebrews 1:3* — Sustaining all things by his powerful word.

- When you think about the wonder of it all, what part of God's story impacts you the most?
- Why do you think it's easy to lose a sense of awe in everyday life?
- What does it look like to respond to Jesus with trust, not just understanding?
- How might your life look different this week if you truly lived in awe of who Jesus is?



## Practical Steps

- Spend a few minutes each day thanking God for something in creation that points to Him.
- Read Colossians 1:15–20 slowly and reflect on what it says about Jesus.
- Write down one area of your life where you need to trust that Jesus is holding things together.
- Share with someone one thing from this message that helped you see Jesus more clearly.

**What is one step you will take this week to live with more awe and trust in Jesus?**

## Apply It

**Reflection Moment:** One area where I need to trust that Jesus is holding everything together is \_\_\_\_\_.

**Action Step:** Choose one step from the Practical Steps and intentionally practice it this week.

**Pray Together:** Thank God for His plan from the beginning and for sending Jesus to reconcile us to Himself.
