

Never Give Up

Galatians 6:9 – “Let us not grow weary in doing good, for at the proper time we will reap a harvest if we do not give up.”

Point 1: Persevere Through Trials

James 1:12 – “Blessed is the one who perseveres under trial because, having stood the test, that person will receive the crown of life that the Lord has promised to those who love Him.”

Trials are part of life, but they are not meant to destroy us—they are meant to build us.

God uses difficulties to strengthen our faith, develop our character, and prepare us for greater things.

When facing opposition, sickness, financial struggles, or spiritual battles, remember that God is with you.

Example: The story of Job—despite losing everything, he never gave up, and in the end, God restored him.

Point 2: Trust in God's Timing

Supporting Scripture: Isaiah 40:31 – “But those who wait on the Lord shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings like eagles, they shall run and not be weary, they shall walk and not faint.”

Sometimes, breakthroughs take time, but God's promises are sure.

Waiting is not a sign of weakness but of trust. God is never late; He works in His perfect time.

Keep praying, keep believing, and keep moving forward—even when you don't see immediate results.

Example: Joseph in Egypt—he was betrayed, imprisoned, and forgotten, but he remained faithful, and in God's time, he was elevated to power.
