

- ❖ **+Psalms 133:** Behold how good and pleasant it is when brethren come together in unity for there the Lord command His blessings even life forevermore. **Regardless** of God's presence, always know the Satan is also present, to cause **confusion – distraction - discouragement – Prayer –** the Lord pour out His Spirit open mind to **understand His will, and ways,** heart to **embrace His plan in unity.**

- ☐ Tell the person sitting next to you – Neighbor: - No matter what am facing,
 - No matter what color my situations are,
 - No matter what life may bring, **God is who He is!**

Qn. What is the best season/ time to love God the more?

- Is it in summer when the weather is good? Or - only when our health is good? Or - when we have money? Or - when we are happy? - when we are living luxury life? - when we have food on our table? etc. *what is the best time you love God more?*
- **The best season/ time to love God the more is when life seems to make no sense to you and me.**
 - ☐ *when we can't understand the situation. **Proverbs 3:5-6***

TOP: TRUST GOD EVEN WHEN LIFE SEEMS TO MAKE NO SENSE.

- ✓ *When we love God, we will love nothing in comparison to Him rather than submit to Him alone.*
- ✓ *When we are ready to give up our comfort to do or suffer anything in order to glorify God.*

1. Love God for who He is not for what He gives, Job 1: 20-22 (little understand)

→ *Job's test tells us; we must love God in all season and time. - whether He gives or not, blesses or not, heals or not.*

Qn – remains; what's the best season to love God? or do we love God for what He gives or for who He is?

Trusting God doesn't mean we can't face hardship

- ☐ *Many believers today think that that trusting in God can stop them from facing trouble of the world, so when troubles come, trial and persecution visited, they forget and start to question God's goodness and justice.- But **Job 2:10**, encourage us never to give up on God when He allow us to have bad experience but love Him the more even when life seem to make no sense to us.*

Root our faith in Christ Jesus.

- ☐ *Because when we root our faith in Christ Jesus, His duty is to rise us from death to life. **(How can we root...?)** By learning His ways through His word and Spirit. **John 1:1**- everything begins with the word.*
 - *One thing these days most people does is, they believe only when they are healed, delivered, or blessed.*
 - *But as children of God put your confidence in God's word when faith is tested; - **We must know that God is healer whether He heals or not, deliverer – delivers us or not, provider -blesses us or not.***

❖ Rem: Being a child of God, does not mean He will always take us in straight line.

- ☐ *There will be storms, name calling, disappointment, sickness, delays and all those are part of God's plan **But we must know that His plan are not of evil Jere 29:11***
- ☐ *But only your confidence in His word will make a difference.*

2. God is faithful to those who are faithful to Him. Daniel 3:12-18

- According to the scripture, it points out that these three men were men of authority, position, and possession – they had wealth, and everything.
- They were in charge of all the affair in the province of Babylon after the interpreting King Nebuchadnezzar's dream. - But **Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego** had every reason to shift their ground when their faith was tested.
- They had every reason to protect their faith. - they never mind of losing their position, rather in all they stood still. **(16-18)** knowing that God is faithful to those who are faithful to Him.
 - ◆ They trusted God and they were determined to be faithful even though they knew the consequence.
 - ◆ They honor God and God honor them before men.
- Church we can't practice true faith if we have not gotten to that point of believing that even if God did not heal me, I will service Him. - **it maybe you are looking for fruit of the womb, or battling with serious sickness or affliction, name them.**
- We can't not practice true faith if we are living like Thomas. **John 20:25**

3. **When we express a genuine faith, God will reveal His mighty power. Gen.22**

- This reminds us how faithful Abraham was to God even when giving Isaac (the only son) for sacrifice seems to make no sense to him.
- He trusted God that even if he sacrifices Isaac God will raise him from death to fulfil His promise.

Conclusion:

- ★ Church trust God even when you do not understand it.
- ★ Christians' trust and believe on God today are conditional.
- ✓ We want to believe that is the healer when He heals us.
 -deliverer when He delivers us.
 -provider when all our debt is being paid.
- ★ **Brethren, let's stop being conditionally and believe that; -**
 - **Same grace that rescues Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego is still available.**
 - **Same power that raised Jesus from the death is still working**
