

## **The God of All Nations”(15 minutes)**

Psalm 86:9 • Isaiah 2:2 • Matthew 28:19

### **1. INTRODUCTION — GOD’S HEART FOR NATIONS**

Today, as we celebrate International Day, we remember this truth:  
God is not a local God — He is the God of all nations.  
Every tribe, every culture, every flag belongs to Him.

Psalm 86:9 says:

“All nations You have made will come and worship before You.”

This is God’s desire: a united global family worshipping Him.

#### **POINT 1 — EVERY NATION HAS A PURPOSE IN GOD (4 minutes)**

You are not just from Congo, Kenya, Cameroon, Nigeria, Burundi, Uganda, Jamaica, Haiti, Fiji, or Canada.

You are from a nation that God designed with purpose.

#### **Every nation carries a spiritual assignment:**

Israel carried the Messiah

Greece carried wisdom

Rome carried governance

Africa carries prayer, worship, and spiritual fire

The Caribbean carries joy and praise

The Pacific Islands carry purity and hospitality

Canada carries peace and refuge for nations

God does not waste geography.

Where you come from is part of who God created you to be.

#### **POINT 2 — GOD IS GATHERING NATIONS TO HIS HOUSE (5 minutes)**

**Isaiah 2:2 says:**

“All nations shall flow to the mountain of the Lord.”

House of Mercy is not an ordinary church.

It is a prophetic sign of Isaiah 2:2.

God is literally gathering nations in one house.

**Why is God bringing nations together?**

To heal old wounds

To break cultural division

To raise global leaders

To build a church that reflects heaven

To release a multicultural anointing

To strengthen the end-time church

Some of you left your countries thinking it was for jobs, visas, school, or safety—  
But in the Spirit, God was bringing you to His mountain.

You didn't just come to Canada.

You came to your divine appointment.

**POINT 3 — WE ARE CALLED TO BE A BLESSING TO THE WORLD (4 minutes)**

**Matthew 28:19 says:**

“Go and make disciples of all nations.”

Before nations came to us, God already told the church to go to them.

Now, God has brought them to our doorstep —  
we must not miss this divine opportunity.

**Our calling as a multicultural church:**

Pray for the nations

Celebrate nations

Heal nations

Raise leaders from nations

Send people back to their nations with the Gospel

Build a house where every culture sees Jesus  
This is not a normal church.  
This is a global mission center.

**Unity + diversity = apostolic power.**
