Sermon Series: ARE YOU READY FOR CHRISTMAS?

Sermon Title: "Preparing For the Christmas Miracle"

Scripture: Luke 1:5-25 (NIV)

INTRO: It's easy to get in the routine of living the daily grind of life and forget to keep our eyes peeled for the \_\_\_\_\_\_ (miraculous).

HOW TO PREPARE FOR THE CHRISTMAS MIRACLE:

- Live life on \_\_\_\_\_\_ (call) for God (v.6)
   -even though they were not seeing anything miraculous, Zechariah & Elizabeth were still living
   faithful, godly lives
   -Israel was in the midst of 400 years of "silence"
   -when nothing special is happening, and nobody is watching...do you continue to faithfully serve
   the Lord?
- Refuse to let ministry become \_\_\_\_\_ (mundane) (vv.8-9)
  -Zechariah was so focused on doing his duty that he fails to recognize the miracle
  -sometimes we go through the motions of life and forget how significant ministry moments really are
- Keep praying with \_\_\_\_\_\_ (persistence) (v.13)
   -even though Zechariah and Elizabeth were beyond child-bearing years, they kept praying for a
   child
   -Luke 11:10 "Whoever keeps on asking...keeps on seeking...keeps on knocking...will be
   answered"
- 4. Believe that God's Word is \_\_\_\_\_\_ (enough) (vv.18-20) -Zechariah's crime was hearing the Word of God and then demanding more evidence -when we try to re-interpret God's Word, or re-explain for a "new" generation we are questioning the sufficiency of Scripture -GOD'S WORD IS ENOUGH!!!
