| | To have "skin in the game" means that you are (personally) invested in ne or something by giving of your (time), (talents), and (re). |
| HOW [| OO WE PUT SKIN IN THE GAME: |
| 1. | Stop What You Are Doing and (Move) Towards Someone in Need -this will probably be an interruption -it may very well be an inconvenience -the Samaritan didn't wait for the victim to ask for help |
| 2. | Look for (Wounds) That We Can Help Heal -you must get close to see what the wound really is -this is triage: assess the urgency of the need to see what is required for treatment -stop the bleeding, bandage the wound |
| 3. | Apply (Medicines) as Needed -oil & wine were used as antibacterial medicines -spiritually: oil represents the Holy Spirit -spiritually: wine represents the blood of the New Covenant |
| 4. | Get Additional (Help) -as a church body we can provide intensive care -many can do MORE than one -ministry is a team sport |
| 5. | Healing Often Requires (Sacrifice) -the Samaritan gave his time, energy, and finances -he did for one, what we wish we could do for all -Jesus made the supreme sacrifice when he gave his life for our ultimate healing |
| 6. | Know Your (Limits) -the Samaritan left the next day after getting the victim to the inn -understand that we can only do so much -we still must provide for our families |
| | : People need to know how much we (care) before they can care about how much (know)! |
