1. When You've Got a Friend, You've Got _____
-"there was a man all alone" (v.8)

2. When You've Got a Friend, You've Got _____
-"there was no end to his toil, yet his eyes were not content with his wealth, 'for whom am I toiling,' he asked, 'and why am I depriving myself of enjoyment?'" (v.8)

3. When You've Got a Friend, You've Got _____
-"two are better than one...they have a good return for their work" (v.9)
-"though one may be overpowered, two can defend themselves" (v.12)
-"a cord of three strands is not quickly broken" (v.12)
