The Hellish Level: Return (evil) for good b. The Human Level: Return (evil) for evil & (good) for good c. The Heavenly Level: Return (good) for evil
<ol> <li>THE SECOND MILE IS THE (CHARITY) MILE: "I (need) to"         -The first mile is legalism, the second mile is love         -We need to go the second mile when:         a. Our dignity is degraded (Matthew 5:38)         b. Our adversary is victorious (Matthew 5:40)         c. A brother or sister is in need (Matthew 5:42)         d. We are misused or abused (Matthew 43-44)</li> </ol>
<ul> <li>3. THE SECOND MILE IS THE (VICTORY) MILE: "I (want) to" -Are you a Second Miler in all aspects of your life: <ul> <li>a. At work?</li> <li>b. At school?</li> <li>c. At church?</li> <li>d.
