It's Time to (Put) Off -carousing: indulging in one's appetites _____ (excessively) (food, drink, sex, etc.) -drunkenness: state of being (intoxicated) -sexual immorality: the "selling off" of sexual (purity) and sexual (expression) beyond the boundaries of a biblically defined marriage relationship -debauchary: (indulgence) in sensual pleasure -dissension: disagreement that leads to (discord) -jealousy: (envy) of someone or their achievements & suspicion 3. It's Time to Put _____ (On) -compassion: sympathetic pity for the ______ (sufferings) of others -kindness: being friendly, generous, and (considerate) of others -humility: a _____ (modest) view of one's own importance -gentleness: kind and _____ (tender) -patience: capacity to accept delay, trouble, or suffering without getting (angry) -forgiveness: an _____ (intentional) decision to let go of resentment and anger -love: a deep (affection) "Love is patient, love is kind.
