INSTEAL	D OF EXCUSES, LET'S MAKE GOOD CHOICES
-	Do What You (Can) -Divine Providence has put you in a position to help -You can always pray
	Don't Let Your Plans Become (Idols) -Planning is a good thing -However, plans have become idols if we are unwilling to change when Divine Providence puts us in a position to help
1	BIG IDEA: GOD HAS PERMISSION TO CHANGE MY PLANS
	(Prioritize) the Needs of Your Neighbor -Ministry usually messes up your plans -Ask yourself: What would Jesus do
-	Do Whatever (Glorifies) God in the Name of Jesus -Obeying God's Word brings Glory to Him -"In the name of Jesus" means we are serving in the place of Jesus
	BIG IDEA: WHEN WE SERVE IN THE NAME OF JESUS, WE ARE PUTTING HIS FINGERPRINTS ON OUR ACTIONS
	Religious Duty Cannot Be an Acceptable Excuse for (Ignoring) the Needs of Our Neighbor -Our choices are usually not between "good" and "bad" but between "good" and "best" -The "good" can easily become the enemy of the "best"
