NKJV- "Jesus answered and said to her, "If you knew the gift of God, and who it is who says to you, 'Give Me a drink,' you would have asked Him, and He would have given you living water...whoever drinks of the water that I shall give him will never thirst. But the water that I shall give him will become in him a fountain of water springing up into everlasting life."

I. The *OFFERING* of Living Water (v.10)

"Jesus answered and said to her, "If you knew the gift of God, and who it is who says to you, 'Give Me a drink,' you would have asked Him, and He would have given you living water.."

• Jesus offered her "living water" as a free, gracious gift...

She was a Samaritan...Jesus, knowing this, lovedher still. and offered the gift still...

II. The **DRINKING** of Living Water (v.14)

"...whoever drinks of the water that I shall give him will never thirst. But the water that I shall give him will become in him a fountain of water springing up into everlasting life."

- Jesus offered "living water" that He promised would quench her deepest thirst in life, and completely changer her on the inside...
- "Drinking" the living water Christ offers is to receive SALVATION and ETERNAL LIFE!

 OWHYshould you do it? HOWdo you do it?
 - Realize Understand that you have sinned against God.
 - Repent Make a conscious decision to turn away from your life of sin.
 - Receive Open your heart and mind to Jesus today, and receive Him into your life and heart... to be your Lord, your King, your Savior!

III. The *REMEMBERING* of Living Water (1Cor 11:23-25)

"For I pass on to you what I received from the Lord himself. On the night when He was betrayed, the Lord Jesus took some <u>bread</u> and gave thanks to God for it. Then He broke it in pieces and said, "<u>This is my body</u>, which is given for you. Do this in remembrance of Me." In the same way, He took the cup of <u>wineafter</u> supper, saying, "This cup is <u>the new covenant</u> between God and His people—an agreement confirmed with My blood. Do this in <u>remembrance of Me</u>as often as you drink it."

- The Communion supper, is how we remember the sacrifice of the Body and Blood of Jesus for us, to save us from our sins, and give us eternal life.
 - o <u>John</u> 6:35(NLT) "Jesus replied, "I am the Bread of Life. Whoever comes to me will never be <u>hungry</u>again. Whoever believes in me will never be <u>thirsty</u>."
- Symbollically, as we "drink His blood" (In 6:53) and "eat His flesh" (In 6:53), we are remembering His perfect sacrifice for us, and reminding ourselves that we are now forgiven and saved!

o John 6:53–57(NLT) - "So Jesus said again," I tell you the truth, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you cannot have eternal life within you. 54 But anyone who eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life, and I will raise that person at the last day. 55 For my flesh is true food, and my blood is true drink. 56 Anyone who eats my flesh and drinks my blood remains in me, and I in him. 57 I live because of the living Father who sent me; in the same way, anyone who feeds on me will live because of me.
