Seize the Day... for Christ! 1 Corinthians 16:5-9 Pastor Jason Dennett's Notes

NKJV - "Now I will come to you when I pass through Macedonia (for I am passing through Macedonia). 6 And it may be that I will remain, or even spend the winter with you, that you may send me on my journey, wherever I go. 7 For I do not wish to see you now on the way; but I hope to stay a while with you, if the Lord permits. 8 But I will tarry in Ephesus until Pentecost. 9 For a great and effective door has opened to me, and [there are] many adversaries."

NLT - "I am coming to visit you after I have been to Macedonia, for I am planning to travel through Macedonia. 6 Perhaps I will stay awhile with you, possibly all winter, and then you can send me on my way to my next destination. 7 This time I don't want to make just a short visit and then go right on. I want to come and stay awhile, if the Lord will let me. 8 In the meantime, I will be staying here at Ephesus until the Festival of Pentecost. 9 There is a wide-open door for a great work here, although many oppose me."

We learn 3 lessons in managing our OPPORTUNITIES from the Lord:

Like Paul, we should be *PLANNED!* (v.5)

Like Paul, we should be *PLIABLE!* (v.6-7)

• Like Paul, we should be **PASSIONATE!** (v.8-9)

#1 - Like Paul, we should be PLANNED! (v.5)

"Now <u>I will come to you</u> when I pass through Macedonia (for <u>I</u> am passing through Macedonia).

- <u>There's a necessity of **PLANNING** to be successful with</u>
 <u>opportunities in life.</u>
 - **Prov 29:18** KJV "Where there is <u>no vision</u>, the people <u>perish.</u>."

<u>**Pro 24:6**</u> **NKJV -** "For by <u>wise counsel</u> you will wage your own war, And in <u>a multitude of counselors</u> there is safety."

Eph 1:9-10 NLT - "God has now revealed to us his mysterious plan regarding Christ, a plan to fulfill his own good pleasure. 10 And this is the plan: At the right time he will bring everything together under the authority of Christeverything in heaven and on earth.

God is looking for people of ACTION and INITIATIVE!

The "Will of God" is found by being **ACTIVE** and **IN MOTION**...not lazy and sedentary!

"Failure occurs because of 2 reasons: 1. Doing things without planning them. 2. Planning them without doing them!"

Rom 12:1,2 NLT - "And so, dear brothers and sisters, I plead

with you to give your bodies to God because of all he has done for you. Let them be a living and holy sacrifice--the kind he will find acceptable. This is truly the way to worship him. 2 Don't copy the behavior and customs of this world, but let God transform you into a new person by changing the way you think. Then you will learn to know God's will for you, which is good and pleasing and perfect."

- #1 <u>Realize</u> God's Goodness to you. (active!)
- #2 <u>Release</u> your life to God again. (active!)
- #3 <u>Resist</u> temptations and sin. (active!)
- #4 <u>Renew</u> you mind in God's Word. (active!)

#2 - Like Paul, we should be PLIABLE! (v.6-7)

"And <u>it may be that I will remain</u>, or even spend the winter with you, that you may send me on my journey, wherever I go. For I do not wish to see you now on the way; but I hope to stay a while with you, <u>if the Lord permits</u>."

- "GOD, the **Great Author** of Life, has **"editing rights"** over your life!!"
- In our planning, we should remain PLIABLE and FLEXIBLE to how the Lord may change our plans!
 - "Be stubborn about your **GOALS**, but **FLEXIBLE** about your methods."

"Blessed are the **FLEXIBLE**, for they shall not be broken!" - Calvary 1:1

- We see this truth in operation in Paul's **TRAVEL** plans; Paul's LIFE plans; **YOUR** life plans?!?
- James 4:13-16 NLT "Look here, you who say, "Today or tomorrow we are going to a certain town and will stay there a year. We will do business there and make a profit." <u>How do you know what your life will be like</u> tomorrow? Your life is like the morning fog--it's here a little

<u>while, then it's gone</u>. What you ought to say is, "<u>If the</u> <u>Lord wants us to</u>, we will live and do this or that." <u>Otherwise you are boasting about your own plans</u>, and all such boasting is evil."

Rev 4:1-2 NLT - Then as I looked, I saw a door standing open in heaven, and the same voice I had heard before spoke to me like a trumpet blast. The voice said, "Come up here, and I will show you what must happen after this." And instantly I was in the Spirit, and <u>I saw **a Throne**</u> in heaven and Someone sitting on it.

- Isa 6:1 NKJV "In the year that King Uzziah died, <u>I saw the</u> Lord sitting on a Throne, high and lifted up, and the train of His robe filled the temple."
- <u>Prov 16:9</u> NKJV "A man's heart plans his way, But <u>the</u> LORD directs his steps."

#3 - Like Paul, we should be PASSIONATE! (v.8-9)

"But <u>I will tarry in Ephesus</u> until Pentecost. For <u>a great and</u> effective door has opened to me, and there are many adversaries."

- Paul had an incredible PASSION to travel SERVE his Lord, and to EXPAND the Kingdom of Christ!
 - Paul was as careful in his use of time as he was in his use of money. It's obvious in all the cities he traveled through...such as Ephesus!

- He was excited to see the Lord opening up a "great and effective door" of ministry in Ephesus:
- <u>Act 19:8-10</u> NKJV "And he went into the synagogue and spoke boldly for three months, reasoning and persuading concerning the things of the kingdom of God. But when some were hardened and did not believe, but spoke evil of the Way before the multitude, he departed from them and withdrew the disciples, reasoning daily in the school of Tyrannus. And this continued for two years, so that <u>all who dwelt in Asia heard the</u> word of the Lord Jesus, both Jews and Greeks."
 - **Rev 3:7-8 NLT -** "Write this letter to the angel of the church in Philadelphia. This is the message from the One who is Holy and True, the One who has the key of David. **What He opens, no one can close;** and what He closes, no one can open: "I know all the things you do, and I have **opened a door for you that no one can close.** You have little strength, yet you obeyed My word and did not deny Me."
- <u>What are **YOU**</u> passionate about? What get's **YOU** excited and fired up in life?

Things you are **passionate** about, you **talk** about...sports, love, gadgets, ...Jesus?!?

- "A man can be **PASSIONATE** about anything else, but the moment a little fire gets into the Church, people say, "Ah, enthusiasm, passion, false excitement - I'm afraid of that!" - **DL Moody**
- Do you like TOBASCO and HOT SAUCE in your food?? -Jesus does too! He loves fiery Christians, passionate in their pursuit of Him. He wants a little "spiritual hot sauce" on your relationship with Him! He's not satisfied with the bland and basic Christian life. He want you to pursue Him passionately, fiercely, with intensely, with fire in your heart! Be a TOBASCO Christian... not a TOFU Christian!
- <u>**1 Sam 13:14 NKJV -**</u> "The LORD has sought for Himself <u>a</u> <u>man after His own heart</u>, and the LORD has commanded him to be commander over His people.."

<u>Matt 11:12</u> NKJV - "..the kingdom of heaven suffers violence, and <u>the violent take it by force</u>."

What do give you TIME, TALENTS, and TREASURE to in your life?

OBSTACLES in serving the Lord!

In Ephesus, because the Lord moved through Paul in such a might way, satan opposed him greatly: Demetrius and the Riot of the Silver-smiths of the goddess Diana tried to kill Paul and his team! (Acts 19:21-41)

Paul was a <u>SERIOUS THREAT</u> to the Kingdom of Darkness!! - "..the evil spirit replied, "I know Jesus, and I know Paul, but who are you?" - Acts 19:15)

Are <u>YOU</u> a threat to satan's kingdom?!? Am <u>I</u>?!? Are <u>WE</u> as a church family?!?
