As the Great "**I AM**", we will see that...

- I. GOD exists **INDEPENDENTLY** from Creation.
- II. GOD exists **ETERNALLY** over Creation.

I. **GOD exists INDEPENDENTLY from Creation.** - "God said to Moses, 'I AM WHO I AM.' And He said, 'Thus you shall say to the children of Israel, 'I AM has sent me to you.'"

- **GOD, the Great "I AM", is our **CREATOR**:**
 - **Gen 1:1 NKJV** - "In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth."
 - **Gen 1:1 HEB** - "הָאֵרֶץ וְאֵת הַשָּׁמַיִם אֵת אֱלֹהִים בָּרָא בְהַתְחִלָּה."
 - "GOD enjoys His creation." - **AW Tozer**
 - "Everything that GOD has created, is like an orchestra praising Him!" - **Oswald Chambers**
 - "All of creation was created to glorify God. God intended that we would join the created world, in reflecting the beauty and strength of His magnificent Character." - **Joseph Stowell**
 - **John 1:1-4 NLT** - "In the beginning the Word already existed. The Word was with God, and the Word was God. He existed in the beginning with God. God created everything through Him, and nothing was created except through Him. The Word gave life to everything that was created, and His life brought light to everyone."
 - **Col 1:15-16 NLT** - "He existed before anything was created and is supreme over all creation, for through Him God created everything in the heavenly realms and on earth. He made the things we can see and the things we can't see - such as thrones, kingdoms, rulers, and authorities in the unseen world. Everything was created through Him and for Him."

 - **Everything in our universe had a beginning.** Every single atom, of every single substance in our world, was at one point brought into existence by GOD, the great "I AM". He **DESIGNED** it all; He **ENGINEERED** it all; He **FORMED** it all in His infinite Mind....and instantaneously brought it into being! GOD, the great "I AM" gave existence, and shape, and form to everything we see!
 - **Category #1** - All things in our universe are weak, fragile, and **dependent**.
 - **Category #2** - GOD, the Great "I AM" is strong/permanent, He has no beginning, He is uncaused, and He is **INDEPENDENT** of His Creation.
 - To be **INDEPENDENT** means that GOD needs nothing outside of Himself; GOD needs no-one to help Him. GOD is COMPLETE within Himself, and totally **INDEPENDENT** of His Creation.
 - The Name "I AM" proclaims to us that GOD is the living, eternal, self-sustaining Creator of the universe, that the burning bush was a picture of.

- **GOD, the Great "I AM", is our *SUSTAINER*:**

- **Col 1:16-17 NLT** - "Everything was created through Him and for Him. He existed before anything else, and He holds all creation together."
 - **Col 1:17 AMP** - "...in Him all things consist (cohere, are held together)."
- **Heb 1:3 NLT** - "The Son radiates God's own glory and expresses the very character of God, and he sustains everything by the mighty power of his command."
 - **Heb 1:3 AMP** - "...upholding and maintaining and guiding and propelling the universe by His mighty word of power."
 - *Like a singer who **sustains the NOTES** of a song...**GOD sustains you!***
 - *Like a **REFLECTION in a mirror** is temporary...**GOD continually gives you the gift of existence!***
 - *Like a dreamer, who **DREAMS a world** into being...**GOD holds you together!***
 - *Like a fragile **FLOWER**..basking in the light of the sun...**The SON of God shines His light on you every second, keeping you in existence!***

- **Rom 11:36 AMP** - "For from Him and through Him and to Him are all things. [For all things originate with Him and come from Him; all things live through Him..]"

PERSONAL APPLICATION:

- **As Christians, we should be *WORSHIPPING!***
 - *There's a movement of new churches rising across the country, and guess what they all have in common? None of them believe in God! Yes, "Atheist Churches" and even atheist megachurches are becoming more and more popular as people want the warm feelings of a church experience they grew up with, just without God. Sanderson Jones, one of the leaders of Sunday Assembly in Los Angeles, said, "There was so much about it [referencing a Christian church's Christmas caroling event] that I loved, but it's a shame because at the heart of it, it's something I don't believe in," Jones said. "If you think about church, there's very little that's bad. It's singing awesome songs, hearing interesting talks, thinking about improving yourself and helping other people—and doing that in a community with wonderful relationships. **What part of that is not to like?**"*

- **Rev 4:10-11 NKJV** - *"..the twenty-four elders **fall down before Him who sits on the throne and worship Him** who lives forever and ever, and cast their crowns before the throne, saying: "You are worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honor and power; **for You created all things**, and **by Your will they exist** and were created."*

- **As Christians, we should be COMPLETE!**
 - *"A man who went on a cruise, he had saved up all his money to buy a ticket to go on a cruise. He was so excited but knew he only had enough money for the boat. He was thinking to himself, "I don't have enough money for the food that it's going to cost, it would be very expensive on this cruise." So he walks on the boat and in his suitcase is bread, peanut butter and jelly. Day after day he walks by the steak and the lobster and all of the trimmings. And he goes back to his hotel room, pulls out the bread, spreads out a little peanut butter and eats his little toast in the corner with jelly. This went on day after day, until finally walking by that line of those delicacies, he couldn't take it any longer. He finally went up to the captain and says, "Look, I can't take this any longer, I've been on this cruise almost two weeks and this is like the last day. I'll do anything to eat the food that's in that line. I'll wash dishes, anything. And the captain laughed at him and said, "Didn't you know? When you buy the ticket, the food's included."*
 - **Everything you need for life is given to you in a relationship with the Great "I AM" - your Creator and Sustainer.** Yet I meet Christians all the time who are searching for something more in the Christian life. I hear it in their prayers, they want more power, they want more of the Holy Spirit, they want more blessings, they want more glory. They want more, more, more. And God is saying, *"It's yours. It's a package deal. You get the ticket to the boat, you get the meal."*

- **As Christians, we should be SURRENDERED!**
 - *At the end of WWII, the famous General Douglas MacArthur, was meeting his enemy, the top Japanese General. The meeting was set up for the Japanese general to officially surrender, and bring the war to an end. When he stepped in front of MacArthur, the MacArthur's general stuck out his hand to shake MacArthur's hand. The American general didn't respond, but simply said, "I cannot shake your hand, sir, until you first surrender your sword. **We can't be friends as long as that sword is hanging by your side. Give me the sword, and then we'll shake hands.**"*
 - **A lot of us are like that with GOD,** we want to "shake God's hand" and be accepted by Him as friends, while we are *still carrying the sword of our*

own will. We must first surrender our wills to GOD, before we can enter into a close relationship with Him."
