## "RESCUE: The King Has Arrived!" - Palm Sunday (2019)

2 Tim 1:10 NLT - "And now he has made all of this plain to us by <u>the appearing of</u> <u>Christ Jesus, our Savior</u>. <u>He broke the power of death</u>and <u>illuminated the way to life</u> <u>and immortality</u>through the Good News."

<u>John 12:12–16</u>NLT - "The next day, the news that Jesus was on the way to Jerusalem swept through the city. A large crowd of Passover visitors took palm branches and went down the road to meet him. They shouted, "Praise God! Blessings on the One who comes in the name of the Lord! Hail to the King of Israel!" Jesus found a young donkey and rode on it, fulfilling the prophecy that said: "Don't be afraid, people of Jerusalem.

Look, your King is coming, riding on a donkey's colt." His disciples didn't understand at the time that this was a fulfillment of prophecy. But after Jesus entered into His glory, they remembered what had happened and realized that these things had been written about Him."


I. The King's <u>ARRIVAL</u> (v.12-13) II. The King's <u>ANNOUNCEMENT</u> (v.14-15) III. The King's <u>AWESOMENESS</u> (v.16)

**1.** The King's <u>ARRIVAL</u> (v.12-13) -"The next day a great multitude that had come to the feast, when they heard that Jesus wascoming to Jerusalem, took branches of palm trees and went out to meet Him, and cried out: "Hosanna! 'Blessed is He who comes in the name of the LORD!' The King of Israel!"



• 1. <u>LOOK!</u> <u>This is the ONLYinstance where Jesus</u> everENCOURAGESpraise & acclamation to be given to Him!!

•<u>Matt 17:9</u>NKJV- "Now as they came down from the mountain, Jesus commanded them, saying, "Tell the vision to no one until the Son of Man is risen from the dead."



- o "Hosanna" They are asking Jesus to do for them, what religion has not done: bring salvation and deliverance!!
  - People wanted something more than their religion was giving them:more than endless rituals, prescribed prayers, and the same dead ceremonies 613 Jewish laws and ceremonies!

II. The King's <u>ANNOUNCEMENT</u> (v.14-15) - "Then Jesus, when He had found a young donkey, sat on it; as it is written: "Fear not, daughter of Zion; Behold, your King is coming, Sitting on a donkey's colt."

- Over the years, many people have made predictions about the Internet. Not all of these predictions were correct:
  - o2004 Bill Gates' announced that <u>spam would be eliminated within 2</u> years.
  - o1995 The Internet would never be able to handle very much traffic.
  - 1995 The Internet would spell the end of spying and the control of information.
  - o1995 Newsweek's claimed websites would neverreplace newspapers.
  - o1995 Newsweek said no one would buy anythingover the Internet.

• The Bible contains about 2,000 different prophecies! These deal with specific people, specific countries, and specific events of history. These have all been fulfilled with 100% accuracy! Only the Bible has this supernatural ability to predict the future in advance!

- Zech 9:9(500 BC) "Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion! Shout, O daughter of Jerusalem! Behold your King is coming to you; He is just and having salvation, Lowly and riding on a donkey, A colt, the foal of a donkey."
- There is also the fulfillment a magnificent prophecy that was given 483years prior...to the very day! The Book of Daniel was written in about 700 BC!! It's one of the mostimportant in all of Scripture!
  - Daniel 9:25-26NCV "Learn and understand these things. A commandwill come to rebuild Jerusalem. The time from this command until the appointed leader comes will be forty-nine years and four hundred thirty-four years. Jerusalem will be rebuilt with streets and a trench filled with water around it, but it will be built in times of trouble. After the four hundred thirty-four years the appointed leader will be killed.."
- The Persian king, Artaxerxes Longimanus, commanded to restore Jerusalem on *March 14, 445 B.C.* as is confirmed by Nehemiah 2 and secular history books as well.

Sir Robert Anderson in his book "The Coming Prince" determined: 483 years, based on the 360-day calendar year was 173,880 days. If this is

counted out on the calendar it will bring you to *April 6, 32 A.D.* (the 10th of Nisan)

 THIS IS THE PRECISE DAY when Jesus entered Jerusalem riding on a donkey! *Absolutely Amazing*!!

#### • THIS DEMONSTRATES *2 POWERFUL THINGS* TO US:
