Pastor Jason Dennett's Notes

A week before Christmas, a young boy rushes into the family room, causing his mother to stand there with her mouth wide open, and he says, holding huge box in his hands, "We'd better tell Santa Claus to forget about bringing the train set I asked for. I just found one on the top shelf of Dad's closet!"

"And He is before all things, and in Him all things consist. And He is the head of the body, the church,..." (NKJV)

"Y El ha existido antes de todas las cosas, y en El todas las cosas permanecen. El es también la cabeza del cuerpo que es la iglesia." (ESP)

"He existed before anything else, and he holds all creation together. Christ is also the head of the church, which is his body." (NLT)

Starting in Col 1:15, Paul began to describe the Person of Christ, in majestic and glorious portraits. He already told us that Christ is Supreme since He is:

- The **REPRESENTER** of God.
- The **MASTER** who is God.
- The CREATOR with God.
- "When I was a kid, I wanted a basketball for Christmas so bad I could scream! I dropped all kinds of hints. 1. The ORIGINATOR from Eternity: "And He is

before all things..."

NLT - "He existed before anything else.."

The Greek words here "pro panton" meaning before all other things or before any other things was there.

Paul is teaching that Jesus Christ, as <u>God the Son, has</u> <u>always/eternally existed!</u>

John declares Jesus Christ to be:

- The Eternal "WORD" John 1:1 "In the <u>beginning the Word</u>

 <u>already existed</u>, and the Word was with God, and the Word was

 God."
- The Eternal "I AM" John 8:58 "Before Abraham existed, I AM!"
- The Eternal "SON OF GOD" John 17:5 "Father restore to Me the glory that I had with you before the world was created."

"It is not possible that the man who denies that Jesus Christ is God, can be a Christian. He is deliberately refusing the only way of escape from the wrath to come...Depend on it, my hearer, you never will go to Heaven unless you are prepared to worship Jesus Christ as God." - Charles Spurgeon.

• The ETERNAL CHRIST appeared many times in the Old Testament:

Adam-Gen 2; Melchizedek-18; Jacob-28; Joshua 5...

"According to an old legend, one day satan and his demons were having a wild Christmas party. As the demonic guests were leaving, one of them grinned and said to satan, "Merry Merry Christmas, your majesty!" WHAT DOES THIS MEAN PRACTICALLY??

Christ has eternally <u>known</u> YOU, always <u>desired</u> YOU, and

2. The SUSTAINER of all Reality: "..and in Him all things consist."

NLT - "..He holds all creation together."

This Greek word "synestemi" means to "put things together, or stick objects together"

Christ holds, keeps, preserves, sustains <u>ALL</u> of creation together, in it's moment-by-moment existence!!

Christ holds **YOU** together in at least 3 amazing ways:

- METAPHYSICALLY...Christ sustains your existence!
- PHYSICALLY...Christ sustains your atoms!

Daniel Webster was once asked how he could comprehend that Jesus Christ was fully God and fully Man. "No, sir," he replied, and added, "I should be ashamed to acknowledge Him as my Savior if I could comprehend Him. If I could comprehend Him, He would be no greater than myself...I need a superhuman Savior, one so great and glorious that I cannot fully comprehend Him!"

• PERSONALLY.. Christ sustains your soul!

One day a pastor was traveling on a train in Europe. The only other passenger in the cabin with him was a young man, who was reading a newspaper. This young man began to speak to the minister and explain that indeed he was a Christian, but that he was under constant attack from so many temptations, that he didn't think he could stand being a disciple one week longer. The minister simply took from his pocket a small Bible and a pen. He said, "Watch how I can make this pen stand up perfectly straight and balanced on the cover of my Bible, despite the rocking and shaking of the train." The young man doubted it could actually be done, but still watched him with eager anticipation. "This is how it's done" said the pastor, as he simply put his finger on the top of the pen, steadying it upright on top of the Bible. "Well that doesn't

count, you're using your finger to hold it up!" "Of course I am." answered the minister, "Whoever heard of a pen that could hold itself up, all on it's own, without any help?"

8. The LEADER of the Body: "And He is the Head of the Body, the Church..."

NLT - "Christ is also the Head of the Church, which is His Body."

a) As the Leader, Jesus GUIDES the Church...

Rev 1:12,13 - "Then I turned to see the voice that spoke with me.
 And having turned I saw seven golden lampstands, and in the midst of the seven lampstands One like the Son of Man..."

b) As the Leader, Jesus EMPOWERS the Church...

- Acts 1:8 "But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me.."
- "I cannot describe all that Christ is to us, for what is He not to us?
 He is the <u>SUN</u> of our day; He is the <u>STAR</u> of our night; He is our <u>LIFE</u>; He is our life's <u>LIFE</u>; He is our <u>HEAVEN</u> on earth, and He shall be our <u>HEAVEN</u> in Heaven!" Charles Spurgeon

c) As the Leader, Jesus SAVED the Church...

- Acts 20:28 "...shepherd the church of God which <u>He purchased</u> with His own blood."
- "When Jesus came in the form of a Servant, He was not disguising Who God is..He was revealing Who God is!" - John Ortberg
