Then there arose a dispute between some of John's disciples and the Jews about purification. And they came to John and said to him, "Rabbi, He who was with you beyond the Jordan, to whom you have testified-behold, He is baptizing, and all are coming to Him!" John answered and said, "A man can receive nothing unless it has been given to him from heaven. You yourselves bear me witness, that I said, 'I am not the Christ,' but, 'I have been sent before Him.' He who has the bride is the bridegroom; but the friend of the bridegroom, who stands and hears him, rejoices greatly because of the bridegroom's voice. Therefore this joy of mine is fulfilled. He must increase, but I must decrease. He who comes from above is above all; he who is of the earth is earthly and speaks of the earth. He who comes from heaven is above all. II. <u>The HUMILIATION of John</u>. (v.27-30) - "John answered and said, "<u>A man</u> <u>can receive nothing unless it has been given to him from heaven</u>. You yourselves bear me witness, that I said, '<u>I am not the Christ</u>,' but, 'I have <u>been sent before Him</u>.' He who has the bride is the bridegroom; but <u>the friend of the bridegroom</u>, who stands and hears him, rejoices greatly because of the bridegroom's voice. Therefore this joy of mine is fulfilled. <u>He must increase</u>, but I must decrease."

QUESTION: What is this thing called "HUMILITY"??(Pride??)

<mark>"John answered and said, "<u>A man can receive nothing unless it has been given to him</u> <u>from heaven..."</u></mark>

- When someone is successful, God gave it to them!!
- If youare blessed, you can't brag!!
 - <u>1 Cor 4:7(NLT):</u> "What do you have that <u>God hasn't given you</u>? And if <u>everything you have is from God</u>, <u>why boast</u>as though it were not <u>a gift</u>?"
- *Rejoice* in another's accomplishments.. Be happy just to be *a part* of the process!!
- This is the attitude of John the Baptist... "I am what I am, by God's grace!!"

"You yourselves bear me witness, that I said, '<u>I am not the Christ</u>,' but, 'I have <u>been</u> <u>sent before Him</u>.' He who has the bride is the bridegroom; but <u>the friend of the</u> <mark>bridegroom,</mark> who stands and hears him, rejoices greatly because of the bridegroom's voice. Therefore this joy of mine is fulfilled."

- "The friend of the bridegroom had one special duty and that was to guard the bridal chamber and to let no false lover in. He would only open the door when in the dark he heard the bridegroom's voice and recognized it. When he did, he was glad and he went his way rejoicing for his task was complete." - William Barclay
 - John the Baptist is saying,"I'm the best man at the wedding and I'm so happy that my friend, my cousin, who is also my Lord, is getting the bride."

"He <u>must</u>increase, but I <u>must</u>decrease."

- John 3:30 is the Great Antidote for SELF-FOCUSEDLiving!! There's so much of that today. "What about me? What about my needs?" John's disciples were trying to make it all about John. John is saying, "Quit making this about me? This is not about me. This is about Him. More of Him, less of me."
 - When William Carey, the great missionary to India was dying, he turned to his friend, he said, "When I'm gone, <u>don't speak about William Carey</u>.Speak only about William Carey's Savior."
- John's statement is also a statement of *NECESSITY*. If the King has come, the servant should simply fade away. It's wrong to lift up, and focus on a servant, when the <u>KING</u>Himself is here!
- It's as if John is saying to his followers: "He must increase.
 I must decrease and diminish! This has to happen, boys, because I'm simply a messenger. My job, my role, was the forerunner of the Messiah. I, I pointed the way, but now... HE is here. Therefore, Jesus must increase, I must decrease!! HE must become greater and greater in your eyes, and I must simply fade away!!
