The King Revealed: In His Coming!

John 12:12-16

NKJV - "The next day a great multitude that had come to the feast, when they heard that Jesus was coming to Jerusalem, 13 took branches of palm trees and went out to meet Him, and cried out: "Hosanna! 'Blessed [is] He who comes in the name of the LORD!' The King of Israel!" 14 Then Jesus, when He had found a young donkey, sat on it; as it is written: 15 "Fear not, daughter of Zion; Behold, your King is coming, Sitting on a donkey's colt." 16 His disciples did not understand these things at first; but when Jesus was glorified, then they remembered that these things were written about Him and that they had done these things to Him."

- I. The King's PROCESSION. (v.12-13) "The next day a great multitude that had come to the feast, when they heard that Jesus was coming to Jerusalem, took branches of palm trees and went out to meet Him, and cried out: "Hosanna! 'Blessed is He who comes in the name of the LORD!' The King of Israel!"
- 1. <u>SEE whats being done!</u> This is the only instance where Jesus ever allowed praise & acclamation to be given to Him!
 - Matt 17:9 NKJV "Now as they came down from the mountain, Jesus commanded them, saying, "Tell the vision to no one until the Son of Man is risen from the dead."
 - Matt 8:3-4 NKJV "Then Jesus put out [His] hand and touched him, saying, "I am willing; be cleansed." Immediately his leprosy was cleansed. 4 And Jesus said to him, "See that you tell no one; but go your way, show yourself to the priest, and offer the gift that Moses commanded, as a testimony to them."
- 2. <u>LISTEN</u> to whats being said! The crowds were crying out "Hosanna" and quoting Messianic Scriptures! Thousands of people meet him and shouted excitedly: "Hosanna! Save Us Now! " from Psalm 118:26 a Messianic victory song

II. The King's PROPHECY. (v.14-15) - "Then Jesus, when He had found a young donkey, sat on it; as it is written: "Fear not, daughter of Zion; Behold, your King is coming, Sitting on a donkey's colt."

• Over the years, many people have made predictions about the Internet. Not all of these predictions were correct:

2004 - Bill Gates' announced that spam would be eliminated within 2 years.

1995 - The Internet would never be able to handle very much traffic.

1995 - The Internet would spell the end of spying and the control of information.

1995 - Newsweek's claimed websites would never replace newspapers.

1995 - Newsweek said no one would buy anything over the Internet.

- The Bible contains about 2,000 different prophecies! These deal with specific people, specific countries, and specific events of history. These have all been fulfilled with 100% accuracy! Only the Bible has this supernatural ability to predict the future in advance!
- Psalm 118:25,26 (1,000 BC) "Save now...Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord! We have blessed you from the house of the Lord"
- Zech 9:9 (500 BC) "Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion! Shout, O daughter of Jerusalem! Behold your King is coming to you; He is just and having salvation, Lowly and riding on a donkey, A colt, the foal of a donkey."
- There is also the fulfillment a magnificent prophecy that was given 483

 Years prior...to the very day!
- The Book of Daniel was written in about 700 BC!! It's one of the most important in all of Scripture!
- Daniel 9:25-26 NCV "Learn and understand these things. A command will come to rebuild Jerusalem. The time from this command until the appointed leader comes will be forty-nine years and four hundred thirty-four years. Jerusalem will be rebuilt with streets and a trench filled with water around it, but it will be built in times of trouble. After the four hundred thirty-four years the appointed leader will be killed.."

The Persian king, **Artaxerxes Longimanus**, commanded to restore Jerusalem on *March 14, 445 B.C.* as is confirmed by Nehemiah 2 and secular history books as well.

Sir Robert Anderson in his book "The Coming Prince"

determined: **483 years**, based on the 360-day calendar year was <u>173,880 days</u>. If this is counted out on the calendar it will bring you to <u>April 6, 32 A.D.</u> (the 10th of Nisan)

THIS IS <u>THE PRECISE DAY</u> when Jesus entered Jerusalem riding on a donkey! <u>Absolutely Amazing!!</u>

THIS DEMONSTRATES 2 POWERFUL THINGS TO US:

- The Bible truly is GOD'S WORD to mankind! No other book, in the history of man, has ever had the ability to predict the future with 100% accuracy.....yet the Bible has done it over 1,000 times!! It truly is GOD'S WORD to mankind!
- The Christ truly is GOD'S KING for mankind! No the person in history has fulfilled these 300 messianic prophecies, only Jesus of Nazareth. - III. The King's PERSON. (v.16) "His disciples did not understand these things at first; but when Jesus was glorified, then they remembered that these things were written about Him and that they had done these things to Him."

 - "I know men and I tell you that <u>Jesus Christ is no mere man</u>. Between Him and every other person in the world there is no possible term of comparison. Alexander, Caesar, Charlemagne, and myself have founded empires. But on what did we rest the creation of our genius? Upon force. <u>Jesus Christ founded His empire upon love</u>; and at this hour millions of men would die for Him." Napoleon Bonaparte
- "I am a historian, not a believer, but I must confess as that this penniless preacher from Nazareth is irrevocably the very center of human history. Jesus Christ is easily the most dominant figure of all time." H.G. Wells
- "He was born in an obscure village, the child of a peasant woman. He grew up in another village. He worked in a carpenter shop until He was thirty. Then for three years He was an itinerant preacher. He never owned a home. He never wrote a book. He never held an office. He never had a family. He never went to college. He never put His foot inside a big city. He never traveled two hundred miles

from the place He was born. He never did one of the things that usually accompany greatness. He had no credentials but Himself... While still a young man, the tide of popular opinion turned against him. His friends ran away. One of them denied Him. He was turned over to His enemies. He went through the mockery of a trial.
