## John's Gospel – A Most Unique Book! John 20:30-31

<u>NKJV</u> - "And truly Jesus did many other signs in the presence of His disciples, which are not written in this book; but these are written that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that believing you may have life in His name."

- I. John's Gospel is a unique <u>PUBLICATION</u>.
- II. John's Gospel has a unique **PERSPECTIVE**.
- III. John's Gospel has unique PICTURES.
- IV. John's Gospel has a unique **PURPOSE**.
- V. John's Gospel is about a unique *PERSON*.
- I. John's Gospel is a unique *PUBLICATION*. "...not written in this book.."
  - John is 1 of 4 Gospels very unique from the "Synoptics."
  - Certain events of Jesus' life are NOT present in John's Gospel:
    - o The <u>genealogy</u> of Jesus
    - o The <u>birth</u> of Jesus
    - o The <u>baptism</u> of Jesus
    - o The <u>Sermon</u> on the Mount
    - o The <u>Prophecy</u> teachings
  - But 90% of this book is completely *UNIQUE* to John:
    - o Prologue, showing Jesus deity and eternality
    - Miracle at Cana
    - o Private encounter with Nicodemus
    - o Personal conversation with the Samaritan woman
    - o Raising of Lazarus from the grave
    - Washing of the disciples feet
    - Last Supper with the Upper Room Discourse

- o High Priestly Prayer (John 17)
- o More teaching on the Holy Spirit than any other Gospel.
- Of the 3.5 years of Jesus ministry John <u>focuses only on 20 days</u> and omits the 2nd year entirely!!

## II. John's Gospel has a unique <u>PERSPECTIVE</u>. - "...but these are <u>written</u>.."

- Each of the Gospels portrays Jesus from a special perspective
  - 4 Gospels 4 unique viewpoints (a diamond)
    - <u>Matthew</u> Jesus as the <u>Messiah</u> from God "Behold your <u>KING!</u>"
    - Mark Jesus as the <u>Servant</u> of God "Behold your <u>SERVANT!</u>"
    - Luke Jesus the Perfect Man of God "Behold the MAN!"
- But John's Gospel presents Christ in a way that is absolutely unique...
  - John Jesus is God in human flesh!! "Behold your GOD!"

III. John's Gospel has unique <u>PICTURES</u>. - "..truly Jesus did <u>many</u> other signs in the presence of His disciples, which are not written in this book; but these are written.."

- John records 7 miraculous SIGNS that Jesus performed. (Sign'/wonder/'miracle')
- 1. Transforming Water into wine at a wedding in Cana..
- 2. Healing a Nobleman's dying son by speaking it..
- 3. Healing the crippled paralytic of 38 years..
- 4. Miraculously feeding over 5,000 people with just 5 loaves and 2 fish...
- 5. Supernaturally walking on the stormy waters of Galilee..
- 6. Healing a man blind from his birth..
- 7. Raising Lazarus back to life, after he died days earlier..
- 8. ?!?Raising Himself back to life as He said He would?!?
- John records 7 special "IAM" statements that Jesus declared.
  - o "I AM" the **BREAD** of Life. (John 6)
  - o "I AM" the LIGHT of the world. (John 8)
  - o "I AM" the <u>DOOR</u> of salvation. (John 10)
  - o "I AM" the Good **SHEPHERD**. (John 10)
  - o "I AM" the <u>RESURRECTION</u> and the LIFE. (John 11)
  - o "I AM" the <u>WAY</u>, the <u>TRUTH</u>, and the <u>LIFE</u>. (John 14)
  - o "I AM" the True VINE. (John 15)

IV. John's Gospel has a unique *PURPOSE*. - ".. these are written that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God.."

- To help his readers understand the <u>Jesus is the Lord Himself, come down</u> in human flesh to save the world; Jesus is truly GOD the SON!!
- Thru this belief in Jesus' true identity, John desires for his readers to experience a
  deeper <u>FAITH</u> in Christ, and richer <u>LIFE</u> with Christ!
  - o "that you may **believe**..and that believing you might have **life** in His Name."
- 1. Not only a historical narrative, bit it's also *inspirational* and *applicational*.
- 2. **98x the word "Believe!"** Faith in Christ will be birthed and increased!
- 3. Believing as **BELIEVERS** Not just evangelistic
  - A Trust in Jesus that is deep, strong, and settled
- Jesus is the CHRIST sent by GOD the Father to save us!
  - Christos Greek The Anointed One, Messiah, Christ.
  - Mashiach Hebrew Messiah (Yeshua ha Mashiach)
- · "Son of God" title for deity
  - Jesus alone is the Unique Son of GOD
  - Shares the same divine nature as the Father..Jesus is GOD the SON!!
- This Faith in "GOD the SON" will produce SPIRITUAL LIFE in you!
  - "Bios" physical, biological life, externals
  - "Psyche" inner self, thought life, personality
  - "ZOE"- (often accompanied by eternal or everlasting) quality of life

## V. John's Gospel is about a unique PERSON. - ".. Jesus.."

- John's Gospel is all about the <u>**IESUS CHRIST</u>**, the most special Person whose ever lived. Listen to the words of a poem about His uniqueness entitled "*One Solitary Life*":</u>
  - He was born in an obscure village, the son of a peasant woman.
  - He grew up in another village, where he worked in a carpenter's shop until he was thirty. Then for three years he became a wandering preacher.
  - He never wrote a book. He never held an office. He never had a family or owned a house. He didn't go to college. He never visited a big city. He never travelled two hundred miles from the place where he was born. He did none of those things one usually associates with greatness.
  - o He had no credentials but himself.
  - He was only thirty-three when the tide of public opinion turned against him.
     His friends ran away. He was turned over to his enemies and went through a

mockery of a trial. He was executed by the state. While he was dying, his executioners gambled for his clothing, the only property he had on earth. When he was dead he was laid in a borrowed grave through the pity of a friend.

Twenty centuries have come and gone, and today he is the central figure of the human race and the leader of mankind's progress. All the armies that ever marched, all the navies that ever sailed, all the parliaments that ever sat, all the kings that ever reigned, put together, have not affected the life of man on this earth as much as that ONE SOLITARY LIFE.
