I. The **HUMANITY** of Jesus Christ (v.3)

“...concerning His Son Jesus Christ our Lord, who was born of the seed of David according to the flesh...”

- Matt 1 - royal genealogy of Jesus
- Luke 1 - human genealogy of Jesus
- John 4 - Jesus tired & thirsted
- Matt 26 - Jesus was nervous & scared
- John 19 - Jesus bled & died
- **BUT WHY.....????**
- **HEBREWS 2:14** - “Inasmuch then as the children have partaken of **flesh and blood, He Himself likewise shared in the same**, that through death He might **destroy him who had the power of death, that is, the devil**, and **release those** who through fear of death were all their lifetime **subject to bondage...**in all things **He had to be made like His brethren**, that He might be **a merciful and faithful High Priest** in things pertaining to God, **to make propitiation for the sins of the people**. For in that He Himself has suffered, being tempted, He is able to aid those who are tempted.” (Heb 8; Heb 10; 1 Jn 2:2)
- **HEBREWS 9:16,17** - “For where there is **a testament**, there must also **of necessity be the death** of the testator. For a testament is **in force after men are dead**, since it has no power at all while the testator lives.” (Luke 22:20)

II. The **DIVINITY** of Jesus Christ (v.4)

“...and declared to be the Son of God with power according to the Spirit of holiness, by the resurrection from the dead.”

- “Son” in the Old Testament... Pv.30; Ps.2; Dan 7 (Gen 12-32; Exo 3-23)
- “Son” in the New Testament...
- Definitively **PROVEN** in the Resurrection!
- Jesus Himself is the **GOSPEL** that saves us!
