- 1. A Mother's CROSS (v.38) "And he who does not take his cross and follow after Me is not worthy of Me."
- The Cross was the Mission of Jesus while upon the earth. He came here with the intention of giving His life upon the Cross.
- John 12:23-25,27 NKJV "But Jesus answered them, saying, "The hour has come that the Son of Man should be glorified. "Most assuredly, I say to you, unless a grain of wheat falls into the ground and dies, it remains alone; but if it dies, it produces much grain. He who loves his life will lose it, and he who hates his life in this world will keep it for eternal life. ... "Now My soul is troubled, and what shall I say? 'Father, save Me from this hour'? But for this purpose I came to this hour."
- For mothers, this is <u>the intentional purposeful decision</u> that is made to live out God's primary Mission and Calling for your life: <u>BEING A GODLY</u> <u>MOTHER!</u>
- Eph 2:10 NKJV "For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them."
- "Make the beds, bandage heads, and straighten up the rooms; Wash the windows, cut the grass, see the flowers bloom; Drive the kids to school, then drive them back again; Have the Scouts for a meeting, then I'm cleaning up the den; Serve on my committee, then attend the PTA; I forgot to buy the children's shoes, no time for that today! I'll pay the bills, then write a note, then fill the cookie jar; Oh dear, I just forgot to go, and have them fix the car; Catch up on the ironing, scrub the kitchen floor, answer phone and doorbell, need I list some more? My pet peeve, I must admit, you surely will agree; when someone asks, "Are you employed?", I answer "No, not me!"
- <u>Psalm 127</u>, "Children are a heritage from the Lord, the fruit of the womb is his reward." You know one translator says you could translate the word "heritage" into "assignment." "Children are an assignment from the Lord." The real "homework" is in the home. You do the work in the lives of those children. They're an assignment.

I remember on one occasion her praying like this: "Now, Lord, if my children continue on in their sins, it will not be from ignorance that they perish. And my soul must bear a swift witness against them at the day of Judgement, if they do not come to Christ in salvation!" That thought of my own mother bearing witness against me, pierced my conscience and stirred my heart. This pleading with God for them, and pleading with them for God, is the true way to bring children to Christ."
  - 2. A Mother's COST (v.39) "He who finds his life will lose it, and he who loses his life for My sake will find it."
- <u>NLT</u> "If you cling to your life, you will lose it; but <u>if you give up your life</u> <u>for me</u>, you will find it."
- For a mother, this speaks of the sacrificial service that is given in fulfilling God's calling on your life as a <u>GODLY MOTHER</u>.
- o John 13:3-5,12-15 NKJV "Jesus, knowing that the Father had given all things into His hands, and that He had come from God and was going to God, rose from supper and laid aside His garments, took a towel and girded Himself. After that, He poured water into a basin and began to wash the disciples' feet, and to wipe them with the towel with which He was girded. ... So when He had washed their feet, taken His garments, and sat down again, He said to them, "Do you know what I have done to you? You call Me Teacher and Lord, and you say well, for so I am. If I then, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also ought to wash one another's feet. For I have given you an example, that you should do as I have done to you."

- Because of your bearing your <u>CROSS</u> intentionally, and because of the great <u>COST</u> sacrificially, you will be <u>CROWNED</u> eternally and permanently, by God Himself in Heaven!
- NLT "If you receive a prophet as one who speaks for God, you will be given the same <u>reward</u> as a prophet. And if you receive righteous people because of their righteousness, you will be given <u>a reward</u> like theirs. And if you give even a cup of cold water to one of the least of my followers, you will surely be <u>rewarded</u>."
- "reward" is the Greek word "μισθός" or "misthos" meaning "a payment for work, a wage for labor, a reward for services rendered."
- Heb 11:6 NKJV "..he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him."
- <u>Heb 6:10</u> NKJV "For <u>God is not unjust to forget your work and labor of love</u> which you have shown toward His name, in that you <u>have ministered</u> to the saints, and <u>do minister.</u>"
- Rev 22:12 NLT "Look, I am coming soon, bringing my reward with me to repay all people according to their deeds."

## Mothers will be rewarded and CROWNED at the Judgment Seat of Christ:

• <u>1 Cor 3:11-14</u> NLT - "For no one can lay any foundation other than the one we already have--Jesus Christ. Anyone who <u>builds on that foundation may use a variety of materials</u>--gold, silver, jewels, wood, hay, or straw. But <u>on the judgment day, fire will reveal what kind of work</u> each builder has done. The fire will show if a person's work has any value. If the <u>work survives, that builder will receive a reward.</u>"

• Rev 4:4,10-11 NLT - "Twenty-four thrones surrounded him, and twenty-four elders sat on them. They were all clothed in white and had gold crowns on their heads. ... 10 the twenty-four elders fall down and worship the one sitting on the throne (the one who lives forever and ever). And they lay their crowns before the throne and say, 11 "You are worthy, O Lord our God, to receive glory and honor and power. For you created all things, and they exist because you created what you pleased."

These CROWNS signify the Ministry & Authority they will possess in the Kingdom of Heaven:

- <u>Luke 19:15-19</u> NLT "After he was crowned king, he returned and called in the servants to whom he had given the money. He wanted to find out what their profits were. The first servant reported, 'Master, I invested your money and made ten times the original amount!' "'Well done!' the king exclaimed. 'You are a good servant. You have been faithful with the little I entrusted to you, so you will be governor of ten cities as your reward.' "The next servant reported, 'Master, I invested your money and made five times the original amount.' "'Well done!' the king said. 'You will be governor over five cities.""
- Rev 2:27 NLT "They will rule the nations with an iron rod and smash them like clay pots."
- Rev 3:21 NLT "Those who are victorious <u>will sit with me on my throne</u>, just as I was victorious and sat with my Father on his throne."

- 1 Cor 15:58 NLT "So, my dear brothers and sisters, be strong and immovable.
