INTRODUCTION: Florence Chadwick & Catalina Island - "If I only could've seen the shore, I think I could've made it."

<u>NKJV</u> - "If then you were raised with Christ, **seek those things which are above**, where Christ is, sitting at the right hand of God. **Set your mind on things above**, not on things on the earth. For you died, and your life is hidden with Christ in God. When Christ who is our life appears, then you also **will appear with Him in glory.**"

NLT - "Since you have been raised to new life with Christ, set your sights on the realities of heaven, where Christ sits in the place of honor at God's right hand. Think about the things of heaven, not the things of earth. For you died to this life, and your real life is hidden with Christ in God. And when Christ, who is your life, is revealed to the whole world, you will share in all his glory."

I. **<u>DIRECTION</u>** towards Heaven. - "If then you were raised with Christ, **seek those things which are above**, where Christ is, sitting at the right hand of God."

"If then you were <u>raised with Christ</u>,.." **Referring back to Colossians 2**... **WDJD**?? "<u>W</u>hat <u>D</u>id <u>J</u>esus <u>D</u>o??"

"...<u>seek those things which are above</u>, where Christ is, sitting at the right hand of God."

Greek "zeteo" - meaning to strive, crave, desire, long

for (Present, Active, Imperative tense!!)

How can we **SEEK** the things of Heaven **PRACTICALLY**??: 4 simple ways

1. <u>Use your **TIME**</u>: Invest it for the Kingdom on a regular basis!

How do YOU use your day; week; month; year??
@25 years just working...
@25 years just sleeping...
@9 years just eating...
@5 years just miscellaneous...
@2 years just waiting at lights...
@1 year just tying their shoes...
How much <u>TIME</u> is left over?? @ 3-8 years!!
86,400 seconds per day...2 billion seconds in 70yrs!

2. <u>Use your **TREASURES**</u>: Generously give to Kingdom works!

How do you use your **finances** in general?? Food...Entertainment...School...Credit cards & Debt...Vacations... We are in the **top 5%** of the worlds income!

How do you use your finances for the Lord?? Do you regularly tithe 10%?

Greek "*phroneo*" - to ponder, to think upon, to let something fill your thoughts.

By SITTING in prayer to the LORD! Jesus' prayer life...Matt 26:36-44..Matt 6:9,10 Public & Private

By STUDYING the Words of God!

Psalm 1 - **Be nourished** by thinking on Heaven! Psalm 119:105 - Let Heaven **illuminate** your life! Romans 12:2 - **Transform** how you imagine Heaven! "It is the Christian whose imagination should soar beyond the stars." - **Warren Wiersbe**

By SUFFERING thru trials in life!

<u>2 Cor 11:23-28</u> - Paul's description of his many intense sufferings and physical trials.

<u>2 Cor 5:1-4 NLT -</u> "For we know that when **this** earthly tent we live in is taken down (that is, when we die and leave this earthly body), we will have a house in heaven, an eternal body made for us by God himself and not by human hands. We grow weary in our present bodies, and we long to put on our heavenly bodies like new clothing. For we will put on heavenly bodies; we will not be spirits without bodies. While we live in these earthly bodies, **we groan and sigh**...**we want to put on our new bodies** so that these dying bodies will be swallowed up by life."
