"And at this point His disciples came, and they marveled that He talked with a woman; yet no one said, "What do You seek?" or, "Why are You talking with her?" The woman then left her waterpot, went her way into the city, and said to the men, "Come, see a Man who told me all things that I ever did. Could this be the Christ?" Then they went out of the city and came to Him. In the meantime His disciples urged Him, saying, "Rabbi, eat." But He said to them, "I have food to eat of which you do not know." Therefore the disciples said to one another, "Has anyone brought Him anything to eat?" Jesus said to them, "My food is to do the will of Him who sent Me, and to finish His work. Do you not say, 'There are still four months and then comes the harvest'? Behold, I say to you, lift up your eyes and look at the fields, for they are already white for harvest! And he who reaps receives wages, and gathers fruit for eternal life, that both he who sows and he who reaps may rejoice together. For in this the saying is true: 'One sows and another reaps.' I sent you to reap that for which you have not labored; others have labored, and you have entered into their labors." And many of the Samaritans of that city believed in Him because of the word of the woman who testified, "He told me all that I ever did." So when the Samaritans had come to Him, they urged Him to stay with them; and He stayed there two days. And many more believed because of His own word. Then they said to the woman, "Now we believe, not because of what you said, for we ourselves have heard Him and we know that this is indeed the Christ, the Savior of the world."

I once heard of a well-known family... the Smith family. They were proud of their family heritage because their ancestors came over with the Pilgrims, on the Mayflower. In their family tree were senators and pastors and Wall Street wizards. The Smith family wanted to compile a family history to pass on as a legacyto their children and grandchildren, of the family tree and history. They hired an author to write about the family. There was only one problem, which they knew about, and were sensitive about: Uncle George, a criminal in their family history, had actually been executed in the Federal prison for murder; he was electrocuted in the electric chair. The Smith family didn't know how the author was going to write about that. However, author said, don't worry about it, I'm good at spin, I'll come up with something very creative. And so when the book was finally completed, the family immediately wanted to see what he wrote about Uncle George. This is what he wrote: 'George Smith occupied a chair of applied electronics, at an important government institution. He was attached to his position by the strongest of ties, and his death came as a real shock.'

In 1949 a man named John Currier, was convicted of murder, and then sentenced to life imprisonment. He was living out his life sentence when after several years he was paroled to a work farm environment, and a work farm near Nashville, Tennessee. Then in 1968, his sentence was terminated, and a letter was sent to him to tell him he was a free man. He never saw the letter. He never got it. He never was told about it, he never read it, and so he stayed working on the farm for ten more years, until finally a state parole officer heard about it, and he personally told him about it, found the letter, showed it to him. John Currier was released. Here's the question that follows that story. Would it matter to YOU if somebody sent you an important message, the most important message of your whole life, but year after year after year after year it WASN'T DELIVERED TO YOU?!?

III. The **FOCUS** of Witness. (v. 39-42)

- As you walk the path of witnessing, as you go down the road of "sharing your faith", there are hundreds of *detours* that will threaten to take you *off course*:
 - o "Church hypocrisy"
 - o "Church errors"
 - o "Religious disagreements"
 - oSilly questions..
 - Weird confusions..
 - GOLDEN RULE: Bring it back to JESUS!

There was once a farmer who wanted to be an evangelist. He was in his mid-life and he was going through his mid-life crisis and he thought he wanted to leave the farm and preach the gospel. And he was sitting under a tree one day, looking up at the sky in between chores, and he noticed what seemed to him like letters being formed by the clouds. And maybe he was reading into it, but he thought he saw two letters P C and he thought, huh, PC, what could that mean? Oh! He said, I get it! It's a sign from God. He wants me to preach Christ! He went off on that and sold his farm and started an evangelistic ministry. The only problem was the guy couldn't preach his way out of a bucket. He was just a poor speaker. And at one evening at a failed evangelistic event one of his dear neighbors, who was also a farmer, went up to the man and whispered in his ear, "Maybe God was simply trying to tell you plant corn." (We're all called to preach Christ, whether you see a sign or not, or whether you're a good speaker or not!)
