- I. The CONFRONTATION of Jews. (v. 22-26) "After these things Jesus and His disciples came into the land of Judea, and there He remained with them and baptized. Then there arose a dispute between some of John's disciples and the Jewsabout purification."
 - "..there arose a dispute.." God's kids can sometimes disagree...
 - o The Church of Jesus is a family... we don't always get along!!
 - <u>Biblical examples:</u> Abraham & Lot, Jacob & Laban, Joseph & his brothers, Peter & Paul, Paul & Barnabas (Comical? Carnal? Corrective?)
 - "God reserves the right to use people that disagree with you!" Dr. Bob Cook, YFC
 - "If you find two people that agree on everything, one of them is not thinking." - Dr. Walter Martin
 - However, there definitely IS a time for Christians to FIGHTfor the Truth of God. Sometimes we need to passionately disagree and oppose false teachingseeks to sabotage the very fabric of the Christian truth.
 - o<u>Jude 3</u>(The Message): "I have to write insisting—begging!—that you <u>fight with</u> everything you have in youfor this faith entrusted to us as a gift to guard and cherish."

• Phil 1:15-17(NLT): "It's true that some are preaching out of jealousy and rivalry. But others preach about Christ with pure motives. They preach because they love me, for they know I have been appointed to defend the

- PRIDE is one of the most destructive and toxic things in the life of a Christian!
 - o "PRIDE must be swiftly dealt with, when detected in your heart... for this is the sin that tuned an ANGEL into a **DEVIL**and **DECEIVER**."
 - o Pride is the first sin recorded in the pages of scripture Isa 14; Eze 28 o What exactly is this thing called "pride"??
 - <u>Psalm 73:8(NLT):</u> "They scoff and speak only evil; in their <u>pride</u> they seek to crush others."
 - <u>Psalm 101:5(NLT):</u> "I will not tolerate people who slander their neighbors. I will not endure conceit and <u>pride</u>."
 - Proverbs 11:2(NLT): "Pride leads to disgrace, but with humility comes wisdom."
 - Proverbs 29:23(NLT): "Pride ends in humiliation, while humility brings honor."
- II. The HUMILIATION of John. (v.27-30) "John answered and said, "A man can receive nothing unless it has been given to him from heaven. You yourselves bear me witness, that I said, 'I am not the Christ,' but, 'I have been sent before Him.' He who has the bride is the bridegroom; but the friend of the bridegroom, who stands and hears him, rejoices greatly because of the bridegroom's voice. Therefore this joy of mine is fulfilled. He must increase, but I must decrease."
- "John answered and said, "A man can receive nothing unless it has been given to him from heaven..."
 - When someone is *successful*, *God*gave it to them!!
 - If *you*are being blessed, you *can't*brag!!
 - o 1 Cor 4:7(NLT): "What do you have that God hasn't given you? And if everything you have is from God, why boast as though it were not a gift?"
 - *Rejoice* in another's accomplishments.. Be happy just to be *a part* of the process!!
- "You yourselves bear me witness, that I said, 'I am not the Christ,' but, 'I have been sent before Him.' He who has the bride is the bridegroom; but the friend of the bridegroom, who stands and hears him, rejoices greatly because of the bridegroom's voice. Therefore this joy of mine is fulfilled."
 - o According to William Barclay, the friend of the bridegroom had one special duty and that was to guard the bridal chamber and to let no false lover in. He would only open the door when in the dark he heard the bridegroom's voice and recognized it. When he did, he was glad and he went his way rejoicing for his task wascomplete.
 - What John the Baptist is saying is, "I'm the best man at the wedding and I'm so happy that my friend, my cousin, who is also my Lord, is getting the bride."
- "He mustincrease, but I must decrease."
 - o John 3:30 is the Great Antidote for SELF-FOCUSED Living!! There's so much of that today. "What about me? What about my needs?" And see, John's disciples were trying to make it all about John. "John, Jesus and His gang--they're getting more people!" And John is saying, "Would you quit making this about me? This is not about me. This is about Him. More of Him, less of me." It's a beautiful, beautiful solution.
 - William Carey, that great missionary to India was dying, he turned to his friend, he said, "When I'm gone, don't speak about William Carey.
 Speak about William Carey's Savior."

o John's statement is also a statement of necessity. He must increase. This has to happen, boys, because I'm here simply as the herald. My job, my role, was the forerunner of the Messiah. I, I pointed the way, but now... HE is here. And now that the King has come, the servant should be fade away. It is wrong to lift up, and focus on a servant, when the KING Himself is here! Therefore, Jesus must increase, I must decrease!! HE must become greater and greater in your eyes, and I must simply fade away!!
